TRAFFICKING FACTS

ANY MINOR being used in the commercial sex industry is automatically considered a victim of human trafficking whether or not there is proof of force, fraud or coercion.

There are an estimated 313,000 VICTIMS of human trafficking in Texas.

An estimated **79,000 MINORS** and young adults are victims of sex trafficking in Texas. Of these, 90% are U.S. citizens.

MIDDLE SCHOOLERS are the target market for traffickers and kids who are in Child Protective Services, homeless or runaways – but the recruiting grounds are widening.

Minors can meet traffickers at parties, malls, bus stops, through SCHOOL FRIENDS AND ONLINE.

750,000 PREDATORS are online at any given moment looking for vulnerable children to target.

83% OF MISSING CHILDREN WILLINGLY LEAVE with someone they know, less than 1% are abducted.

15-20% OF MEN IN THE U.S. have paid to have sex in a hotel room. Buyers of commercial sex are typically college educated, married men with children.

Less than 1% ARE RESCUED. The average lifespan of a trafficked teen is 7 years if they are not recovered.

For those recovered, **HEALING MUST BE LONG-TERM** and multi-disciplinary.

PARENT CHECKLIST

CONVERSATIONS

- Have ongoing age-appropriate, two-way conversations with your child about: real love, secret relationships, age differences, online friendships and romances, sextortion, pornographpy and sex for money
- Help your child establish self-confidence and self-worth
- Establish that you love them unconditionally
- Be clear on your boundaries and rules
- Discuss how to handle mistakes

DEVICES

- Establish who has ownership/control of devices
- · Create and maintain passwords
- Use remote monitoring and parental controls
- Do random checks that enable you to monitor who is communicating with your child
- Set evening shut down times
- · Contact anyone contacting your child
- Report any interaction you are concerned about

FRIENDS & SOCIAL NETWORKS

- Be intentional about knowing your child's friends and the parents of those friends
- Be alert to changes with your child and your child's friends
- Limit your child to 1-2 social media apps; monitor their social media contacts and content
