Recycling: 5,556 gal

Estimated composition: plastic bottles, aluminum cans, cardboard, recyclable food containers, clean paper, plastic utensils, So Delicious containers, aluminum foil

Compost: 2,891 gal

Estimated composition: food scraps, compostable plates/containers, compostable beer cups/coffee cups, firestone cups, utensils, pizza boxes, water cups, soiled paper

Trash: 607 gal

Estimated composition: soiled plastic, coffee cups, wrappers, linens

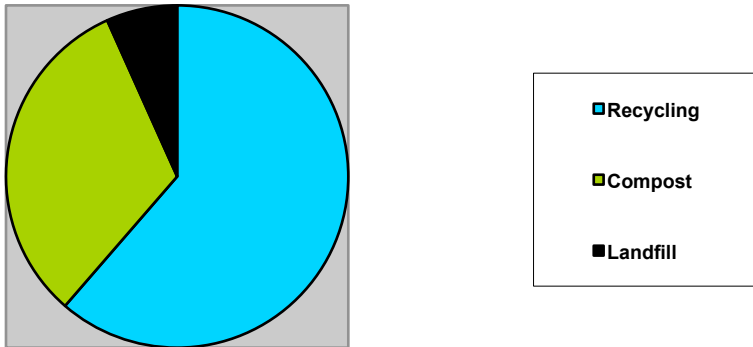
*Amounts determined through converting cubic yards to US dry gallons.

Issues to consider:

- Educate the crowd on the compostability of Firestone beer cups – almost everyone that I talked to in the beer garden was unaware.
- Communicate with **all** vendors about reducing the amount of disposable items they bring to the park.
- Make bigger push for crowd to bring in their own cups and containers.
