John is a faculty member in the vocal arts division at The Juilliard School where he teaches acting.

He is a founding member of The Director Collective, an organization dedicated to Directordriven work.

John's writing includes three plays, *The M. of Versailles, The Immolation of Kathy Chang(e)*, and *Strength of God and other grotesques*. He has also written a new version of Mozart's *The Impresario* for Shenandoah Conservatory of Music and a new English dialogue version of Mozart's *The Magic Flute* for the Chautauqua Institution Festival of Music.
