TOWN HALL THEATRE ANNOUNCES IN THE WINGS STAGED READING OF INCOGNITO BY NICK PAYNE

JANUARY 10, 2020 –Town Hall Theatre continues the *IN THE WINGS* staged reading series with a one-night only performance of *INCOGNITO*, a compelling brainteaser of a play by Nick Payne. *INCOGNITO* will have one performance on Monday, February 3, 2020, at Town Hall Theatre Company, 3535 School Street, in Lafayette, CA. Tickets are \$10 general admission and free to subscribers, and are available through the Box Office at (925) 283-1557 or online at www.TownHallTheatre.com.

Using only four actors to portray 21 characters, Nick Payne's *INCOGNITO* ingeniously weaves together three stories: a pathologist steals Albert Einstein's brain; a neuropsychologist falls in love with another woman; and a amnesiac patient suffering seizures can only remember one thing, the love he has for his wife. In what the *NY Times* termed a "self-examining drama of ideas", the playwright deftly explores the illusory and complicated nature of selfhood, of personal identity and memory. *INCOGNITO* is directed by Anna Smith and will features Town Hall regulars and Bay Area talents.

Performance History

Originally commissioned by the UK's Nabokov Theatre and Live Theatre Newcastle, *INCOGNITO* premiered in April 2014 in a production by Nabokov, Live Theatre Newcastle and the HighTide Festival. *INCOGNITO*'s first U.S. production was in 2016 by the Manhattan Theatre Club.

ABOUT THE PLAYWRIGHT

Nick Payne's plays include If There Is I Haven't Found It Yet (Bush Theatre and Roundabout Theatre Company, New York), Wanderlust (Royal Court Theatre), Sophocles' Electra (Gate Theatre), One Day When We Were Young (Paines Plough/Sheffield Theatres and Shoreditch Town Hall), Lay Down Your Cross (Hampstead Theatre), Constellations (Royal Court Theatre and Duke of York's), and The Same Deep Water As Me (Donmar Warehouse). He is the recipient of the 2009 George Devine Award for Most Promising Playwright, 2012 Harold Pinter Playwright's Award, and the 2012 London Evening Standard Theatre Award for Best Play for Constellations.

ABOUT THE DIRECTOR

Anna Smith is an actor, director, and educator native to the Bay Area who recently Assistant Directed Town Hall's CINDERELLA: A FAIRYTALE. As an actor, Anna has been seen at Bay Area Children's Theatre (TBA Nomination, Beautiful Oops), Town Hall Theatre, and Ray of Light Theatre (SFBATCC Nomination, Assassins). More recently, Anna was fortunate enough to work with New York based director/playwright Morgan Gould on a reading of her new play Three Fat Sisters as part of Cutting Ball's Variety Pack reading series. Anna's directing work has been seen at Quantum Dragon Theatre, Novato Theater Company, and Actors Ensemble of Berkeley. Anna is also the founding executive director of The Quinan Street Project - an organization providing accessible arts education to the West Contra Costa Unified School District, www.QuinanStreet.org
