His purpose is to complete the pilgrimage in 43 days, as a tribute to the lives of 43 boys who disappeared in his home country of Mexico. Along his path, Hernán encounters an abbess, a monk, and fellow Shikoku pilgrims, each with their own unique intentions for undertaking the pilgrimage. As Hernán walks, he finds solace and reflection, processing his past with the guidance and support of those he encounters. The abbess becomes his mentor, helping him shape his future as he continues on his transformative journey.

The **New Voices Series** is a first for Town Hall Theatre, featuring never produced-on-stage plays by local playwrights living in the nine Bay Area counties. The series was created to give a wider-array of playwrights a chance to expose new and in-process works to an audience that may not otherwise be exposed to their stories. These lightly produced productions will include a facilitated talkback at each performance allowing the playwrights the chance to receive feedback from audiences in a constructive manner, while also giving audiences an insight into the theatre maker's process.

Our Adult Storytelling and School Tour program takes us into local schools with performances and workshops, and don't forget about THEd's popular adult improv class Yes, And Wine! Introducing our Yes, And Wine Flex Pass. Passes get you preferred Flex enrollment to any class as well as a Town Hall wine tumbler to enjoy your beverages.

At Town Hall's **Special Events**, audiences will enjoy an array of performances including crowd-pleasing bands, hilarious stand-up comedy or Improv performances, and Cabarets in our intimate Town Hall venue. This Season includes Laurie Roldan and her popular Cabaret, Laurie Sings a Song for You: A Cabaret Concert Inspired by the Music of Karen Carpenter. As well as our Cult Classic Movie Nights, kicking off on September 8th with Mama Mia.

Don't forget about the new *Front Porch Presents* back on our stage in November, featuring local musical talent and the creators Andree and Austin Hurst.
