## **Photographer Guidelines**

#### How to Submit

Submit all photographs to *Nanny Magazine*'s Submittable site: https://nannymagazine.submittable.com/submit

#### format

Send all photographs in JPEG format.

### Credit Line

All photographers whose work has been accepted for publication must send a credit line to use alongside their photo. An example is "Photo courtesy Jane Jones Photography, 2020."

## Resolution

All photographers should submit their work in **high resolution**. Photos for print should be submitted at a **minimum of 300 dpi**. Photos for online should be a minimum of 1200 pixels.

#### Color

Please submit all photos in **color** unless black and white shots are specifically requested.

# Copyright and Permissions

If you have used any material for which copyright is owned by another person or entity, it is your responsibility to obtain the proper permission grants. Please submit proof of permission along with your photo.

#### Model Release

Please include a signed model release form for all persons pictured in your photograph. In cases in which the person pictured is a minor, a model release form must be signed by a parent or legal guardian. Model releases can be signed electronically and uploaded along with your photos in Submittable.

#### Audience

*Nanny Magazine* welcomes submissions from photographers in other countries, but our primary and intended readership is based in the United States.

# Photographer Contract

No submission will be accepted unless a photographer contract has been signed. During the submission process, a link to the contract will be provided. Simply choose "I understand and agree" from the drop-down menu.

## Compensation

At this time, *Nanny Magazine* is not able to provide compensation for photographers. In the future, we hope that this will change. All photographers are encouraged to submit a biography and headshot. You are welcome to include a link to your business page in your biography.
