



**Statement from Women's March Global in response to the recent attendance of a Women's March National board member at a Farrakhan speech.**

We at Women's March Global deeply condemn statements from any persons that seek to divide with hatred or discrimination, including Louis Farrakhan, who has no association with Women's March Global or our team. We cannot and will not allow anti-semitic, homophobic, transphobic or misogynistic language to be a part of our dialogue.

Our Women's March Global team, led by Executive Director Lara Stein, is engaged with thousands of women around the world from Australia to Argentina, from Zambia to Canada. We are the international sister organization of Women's March in the US.

At our core, we are a Global movement, representing the Global Community. Our voice at Women's March Global is intersectional, diverse and flexible, and embodies an open, collaborative and transparent philosophy that aligns and works with other women's rights and human rights groups across the globe.

Women's March Global was founded on the principles that people of all backgrounds – women and men and gender nonconforming people, young and old, of diverse faiths, disabled, immigrants and indigenous – are all deserving of equality, justice, freedom, and inclusion worldwide.

We will continue to embody these principles to amplify and activate issues using education, mobilization, dialogue, engagement and collective action.
