Demolition Derby General Regulations

1. Only one (1) entry per person. Officials reserve the right to accept or reject any application.
2. Each car entry of \$30+HST (\$34.50 total) includes admission for the driver and one (1) pit crew member to the Exhibition Grounds (must be a minimum of 16 years of age).
3. Only full bodied passenger hardtop automobiles or station wagons are allowed. NO trucks, jeeps, convertibles, hearses, or limousines.
4. NO derby cars are permitted in the competition area (track field) prior to the actual competition. All cars will go through a technical inspection for approval before entering the competition area.
5. **ANYONE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING BEVERAGES OR DRUGS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED, NO EXCEPTIONS!**
6. A car will be disqualified if the driver's door comes open during the event.
7. There will be no "BUDDY SYSTEM" or "SANDBAGGING". This may result in disqualification. HITS MUST BE AGGRESSIVE. Simple contact within the time limit DOES NOT constitute combat and COULD LEAD TO DISQUALIFICATION.
8. There will be NO hitting on the driver's side door.
9. When your vehicle is out of competition, the white flag attached to the vehicle by the derby committee personnel is to be broken off. Any competitors hitting a vehicle with a broken flag on purpose, by the judge's discretion, will be disqualified.
10. There will be a horn used for starting, stopping, and caution stops as needed for the competition. This must be adhered to at all times.
11. A drivers meeting will be held at 6:30pm prior to the race time of 7pm; all cars MUST be through tech inspection at this time. Event start time is 7pm but *we recommend that all drivers be on site by 6pm.*
12. The Nova Scotia Provincial Exhibition, the derby committee, or sponsors of the event are not responsible for any cars, parts or personal property, before, after or during the event.
13. ALL CARS must be removed from the track and pit area IMMEDIATELY following the competition.
14. These rules supersede any and all rules that may previously have been in effect.
15. Safety glasses, goggles, or face shield must be worn. Department of Transportation approved helmets must also be worn. It's highly recommended the driver wear a neck brace.
16. The decision of the official will be FINAL.
