Entries will be accepted MONDAY, AUGUST 21, 2017 BETWEEN 4:00 - 6:00 pm in Exhibition Hall. ENTRIES ARRIVING LATE CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

Entry forms and article tags can be picked up at the NSPEC Complex Office at 73 Ryland Ave, Truro, NS, Mon-Thurs 8:00am – 4:00pm or Friday 8:00am – 3:00pm. Entry forms can also be found on the NSPEC Complex website www.nspe.ca.

There will be NO ENTRY FEE for this division.

PLEASE NOTE:

- If you are unable to bring your entries on Monday, please make arrangements to drop them off to the Exhibition Office, 73 Ryland Avenue, Truro, NS, B2N 4C1, Monday to Friday, the previous week. Be sure to complete all the information requested on the entry form and entry tags. Include the class and section, what the article is, your name, and contact information. Attach the tags to the correct entries.
- **Artists may submit no more than one (1) entry per class.** Please select the proper class and division for your entries. The Committee **will not be** responsible for placing articles in classes.
- **Each entry must be framed and ready to hang or it will not be judged.** Print your Name; Title of Painting; Drawing; Sculpture; Category; and Date completed on a separate card and attach to the work of art.
- The committee has the right to refuse articles that do not conform to the proper requirements.
- All entries must have been completed within the last two years and entered for the first time in the Nova Scotia Provincial Exhibition.
- Entries should be original and finished completely by the exhibitor. The entry should be the work of an amateur. An amateur does not earn a full-time living from either fine art sales or from related activities.
- Exhibits defaced by soil or wear are not eligible for competition.
- Two or more pieces comprising one entry are to be securely fastened together.
- The decision of the judge in all cases shall be final. The judge is not required to enter into any discussions or correspondence concerning their decision. In the absence of competition in any class the judges shall award placings as they deem the exhibits merit.
- No article exhibited may be advertised for sale.
- The committee reserves the right to limit the number of articles displayed based on space availability.
- The NSPE and the committee will use all reasonable precautions to ensure safety of the articles entered, but will accept no responsibility for repair, loss or replacement of items submitted. Each exhibitor is urged to have adequate insurance of their own.



Prize Money & Ribbons:

Prize money will be awarded for Overall Grand Champion in each Class. We are actively soliciting prize money for 2017. Prize money will be awarded based on the amount available at the time of judging. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place only per Division. We are actively soliciting prizes for 2017. Prize donors will be placed on the website in the class list as they are confirmed and will be listed in the exhibit area.

Collecting Entries:

Entries, prize money and ribbons must be picked up SUNDAY, AUGUST 27, 2016 **between 6:30 and 8:00 pm** in the exhibit area. Please bring your portion of the entry tag for proper identification when collecting your entries.

If you cannot pick up your entries at this time, collect them from the Exhibition Office, 73 Ryland Avenue, Truro, NS, B2N 4C1 the week following the exhibition between 9AM and 4 PM. **EXHIBITS WILL BE HELD UNTIL SEPTEMBER 8, 2017.**
