Rules/Fees

NSPE Light Horse Show will follow the rules and guidelines outlined through the Nova Scotia Equestrian Federation. Please see www.horsenovascotia.ca for full outlining of rules.

- **NSEF membership or equivalent required for all competitors.** Please forward proof of membership with your entry.
- All entries must be on the entry form provided. Please use a separate form for each horse entered. ***Mailing addresses must be complete.***
- **Protective Headgear:** Although competition management may enforce a stricter helmet policy, all competitions must adhere to the following NSEF Policy on Protective Headwear:
 - NSEF **Helmet Policy:** ***All*** Competitors must wear ASTM/SEI, or BSI/BS EN, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured at all times while mounted or driving at the competition or anywhere on the competition grounds.

 - Exception - **Competitors 19 years old as of January 1st, 2016 competing in the Western Performance Division and Western Horsemanship Class without an approved safety helmet must submit a signed Scotia Series Helmet Waiver** to the competition organizer.
- Closing date is August 9, 2017. Any entry received after this date will be charged a late administration fee of \$20.00. Changes or additions to an existing entry must be made a half hour before the class is scheduled to run. Show committee has the right to refuse any entry.
- Due to time restraints, some classes will be limited numbers.
- Cancellations: Classes with fewer than 5 entries may be cancelled or combined.
- Refunds: Issued only upon receipt of vet or doctor certificate, 75% of fees with certificate received prior to commencement of show.
- Protests regarding riders/horses/ponies eligibility must be made by the second day of the show. Protests will only be accepted with a non-refundable fee of \$25.00 and must be made by a competitor competing at the show. Competitors may address the judge **ONLY** with permission from the Show Secretary and must do so in a polite manner.
- All decisions by the judge and show committee are **final**.

- The PA System is a convenience, competitors must be ringside at scheduled times, classes will not wait! Classes may run late but will not run more than a half hour early.
- Poor sportsmanship or abusive language will not be tolerated in the show ring or on the Exhibition Grounds. The Show Secretary has the right to ask competitors displaying poor sportsmanship to leave the show. No refund will be given
- It is illegal to consume alcohol in the stable area. The Light Horse Show is part of the Nova Scotia Provincial Exhibition, please display your entry and accommodate the public with courtesy.
- Ring numbers will be required during the entirety of the Light Horse Show. This means even during the warm up times. There will be no non registered horse allowed in arena or outdoor ring during the hours of the horse show. Please always wear your ring number.
- There will be posted warm up times for both Thursday and Friday for the MacMillan Show center. These will most likely be the only free times available so please be ready.

- Equitation Classes will **NOT** have prize money.

Rider Classification:

- Senior Riders – 18 years and over as of January 1st.
 - Junior Riders – 18 and under as of January 1st.
 - Ponies can only be ridden by a junior in pony divisions. Seniors are welcome to ride ponies in the senior horse divisions.

Stabling:

- **Stalls will be allotted on a first entry basis. Exhibitors will be notified if stabling requests cannot be accommodated. We are limited to 80 stalls this year so it will be first come first served for stabling and entries.**
- Bedding is provided by NSPE.
- Stabling is designated by stabling requests whenever possible. Please do not change your stabling without contacting the light horse office.
- For those showing ONLY for Jumping in the Infield (Wednesday) showing off of the trailer is permitted.
- Exhibitors will need to bed their own stalls. Bedding will be provided. Stalls must be kept clean at all times and horse adequately fed and watered. Stalls must be cleaned when leaving. **Cleaned not stripped** as MBRA horses will be coming in. Anyone not cleaning stall will forfeit all prize money won.
- **STALL FEES: \$10.00 per day** (any part of day/night)

STALL DECORATING CONTEST

- There will be prizes for best decorated and kept stall area.
- These will be presented as;
 - **1)** Judges choice (light horse judge will walk around on Thursday afternoon to see and choose).
 - **2)** People's choice (there will be voting boxes for the public to vote).
 - **3)** Exhibitors choice (every exhibitor will be given a ballot in your welcome bag so that you may vote in voting box in light horse office).
 - **4)** Sponsors choice (sponsors will be walked through barns on Thursday afternoon/evening prior to or after sponsor reception and parade).
 - **5)** Closest to Exhibition theme, which is "Nourishing Growth".
 - **6)** Committee choice (members of the light horse show committee will vote)
- These awards will be presented Friday evening August 25th around 6:45pm while the course for the Mini Prix is being set.

Jumper Classes 5, 9, 13, 17, 22, 27, 32 one round and a jump off for first place. Running times break all ties after first.

***PLEASE NOTE: There will be a water tank in the infield for water horses. HOWEVER Bring a small bucket to withdraw water with.**

NO HORSES ARE TO DRINK DIRECTLY FROM THE TANK.

English Hack Division

Entry fee is **\$6.00** per class. Stake classes **\$15.00** with **\$10.00 add back**

Each division consists of three under saddle classes. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. In Road Hack rider may be asked to extend the trot and hand gallop .

Trailside Stable Western Division

Entry fee is **\$6.00** per class. Stake class is **\$15.00** with **\$10.00 add back**

Division consists of three western classes. To be shown at a walk, job and lope both directions of the ring.

Exception - **Competitors 19 years old as of January 1st, 2016 competing in the Western Performance Division and Western Horsemanship Class without an approved safety helmet must submit a signed Scotia Series Helmet Waiver** to the competition organizer.

Division consists of three walk/ trot classes open to English and Western riders.

To be shown at a walk and trot/jog directions of the ring.

If numbers warrant, Class will be split into Junior and Senior.

Division consists of 3 pleasure driving classes. To be shown at a walk and trot both directions of ring. Junior drivers must wear a helmet in all classes.

Wayne's Saddlery Team Jumper (Thursday Night)

Team jumper consists of 3 members. Horses may only compete at **ONE** height for team class. All 3 scores count. All eliminated riders to be given 1 point higher than the highest penalized round.

DON'T HAVE A TEAM YET? Let us know you want to participate and we will try to have scramble teams.

As this is the first night of jumper competition in the MacMillan show center; each team will be introduced prior to class starting and will be allowed to jump one line which will be designated. This will get everyone in the ring and hopefully foster a good experience for all combinations. Please note this will be at the .7 height and one time only.

Teams are asked to submit a name and encouraged to have team colors. Ribbons and prize money will be presented to each team member for each placing. **Height to be nominated at office one hour before class for jump orders.**

English Equitation:

To be judged on the rider's seat, hands, management, control of mount and neatness of appearance. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both directions of ring. Possible patterns at the discretion of the judge REMINDER: No prize money is paid out for equitation.

Open to both English and Western competitors. Horse and Riders in this division **MUST NOT** compete in the MBRA.

***Note:** Limited to 15 entry's per class due to time.

Clearance's Feed Ex Open Barrels and Poles

Open to both English and Western Competitors. Open only to Pony and Novice riders of the MBRA. OPEN riders are **NOT** eligible.

(59) Evangeline Trail Rides Showmanship Class

A line class, judged on appearance of pony/horse and exhibitor. The ability to show the pony/horse following a prescribed pattern. Will be divided to junior and senior classes if entries warrant.

(60) Wil Shoe Farrier Service Costume Class

Exhibitors are encouraged to be creative and fun, however, please remember this is a public exhibition and any costume considered inappropriate will not be allowed in the ring. Entries must be bridled, no vehicles (wagons, carts etc.)

(61) Elmbrae Farm Hunter Hack

Entries to walk/trot/canter both ways of ring. Could be asked to hand gallop. Will jump two (2) fences not to exceed 2 feet.

If numbers warrant, class will be split into Pony and Horse.

(62) Sambea Farm Pairs Class

Open to English and western combinations. Entries to walk and trot/jog both directions of the ring. To be judged on performance and ability to work together at all gaits.

Performance 80%, Appearance 20%. Both entries pay entry fees.

(63) Pye's Chevrolet Buick GMC Ltd. Lead Line

To be led at a walk and trot/jog both ways of riding ring. Open to both English and Western attire.

(64) Family Class

Two or more people of a family tree. Horse and pony combinations allowed. Open to English and Western tack. To walk, trot/jog only. Judged as a group on neatness, style dress and suitability as family mounts for pleasure riding. One entry fee per family prize money only paid out as one.
