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The admission process includes the following steps:

- 3.) Schedule a one-on-one student conversation with a member of our admissions team.
- 4.) Schedule a parent/Guardian conversation with a member of our admissions team.
 - a.) Depending on circumstances the student and/or parent conversations may occur in combination with a Small Group tour or Personal Tour
- 5.) Submit your admissions packet in person or online and make sure to include all supporting materials
 - a.) *Something* answering one of the three admissions questions
 - b.) One letter of recommendation from a non-family adult who knows you and can tell us about who you are and how you engage in the world. Letters are welcome to be in the language of choice of the author.
