



Tournament Rules:

- The tournament is open to all female anglers.
- Official tournament hours are 30 minutes prior to sunrise until 4 pm the day of the tournament, rain or shine.
- Wade, bank, surf, jetties, pier or any legal means of fishing is permissible; however, NO SAIL LINES OR TROT LINES are permitted.
- Official weigh-in starts at 2:00 p.m. and ends at 4:00 p. m. the day of the tournament at Redfish Bay Boat House, located at 322 Huff Street at Conn Brown Harbor. All anglers must be IN LINE before 4 p.m.
- There will be two Divisions: Guided and Non-Guided Divisions.
- No males unless operating boat (ONE ONLY)
- Trophies for guided and non-guided 1st & 2nd places in each of the following categories:
Redfish, Trout & Flounder
- Each Team may pick **ONE** category to weigh in **ONE** fish. Team **MAY NOT** enter more than one category. **NO OVERSIZED REDFISH, TROUT OVER TO 25" OR FLOUNDER WILL BE WEIGHED, TAGGED OR NOT.** Heaviest fish wins.
- Team Entries must use **one** boat only for all anglers on team
- In the case of a tie, winner will be decided by length. If length is equal, winner will be decided by time with the winner being the first fish weighed in.

Eligibility:

1. All anglers 17 and older must have a valid Texas fishing license.
2. Any team who wishes to fish in the company of a professional fishing guide during tournament hours must enter the Guided Division only. If it is found a team fished in the company of a professional guide during tournament hours and they were not signed up in the Guided Division the team will be disqualified from the tournament as well as future tournaments.
3. All state and federal penal code and game laws shall apply at all times.
4. All Texas, Coast Guard and State Parks and Wildlife regulations shall apply at all times.
5. Each angler/team must be a registered entrant of the tournament and must abide by all tournament rules and regulations.
6. Tournament directors retain the right to refuse any entry.

Weigh-in/Sportsmanship:

1. All fish weighed in and entered must be caught during official tournament hours on the day of the tournament.
2. All fish presented for weigh-in will be monitored for freshness and will be inspected by a Texas Game Warden or Biologist.

3 NO OVERSIZED REDFISH, TROUT OVER 25" OR FLOUNDER WILL BE WEIGHED, TAGGED OR NOT!

4. All fish must be weighed-in by the team who originally caught the fish and must be in that team's physical possession at the time of weigh-in.
5. Sportsmanship, courtesy, safety and conservation are expected from all entrants.
6. All game laws of the state of Texas, applicable to fishing on public waters, must be followed. Any violations will be cause for immediate disqualification. Any and all winnings will be forfeited.
7. Any and all winners may be subject to and required to pass a polygraph test at the discretion of the Aransas Pass C.O.C. Board of Directors.
8. Any entrant/team found to be in violation of any tournament rules and regulations will be subject to disqualification from this tournament and all future tournaments.

ALL DECISIONS OF MADE BY TOURNAMENT DIRECTORS AND WEIGH MASTER ARE FINAL.

Registration and entry fee:

1. Entry for all eligible anglers is **\$100.00 early / \$125 late**
2. Absolutely no refund of entry fees will be issued.
3. Any entry received after the July 18, 2018 early registration deadline will be \$125.00. NO EXCEPTIONS!
