San Miguel School, a Lasallian middle school, provides a high-quality, holistic education for boys from diverse and challenging backgrounds.

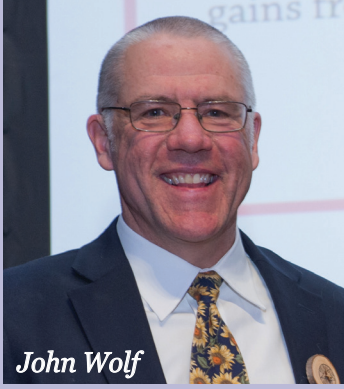
In a caring, safe, and structured environment, we foster a spirit of mutual respect and brotherhood among all students.

Thank you for your faith in this school and your commitment to its Lasallian mission. You will always belong here.

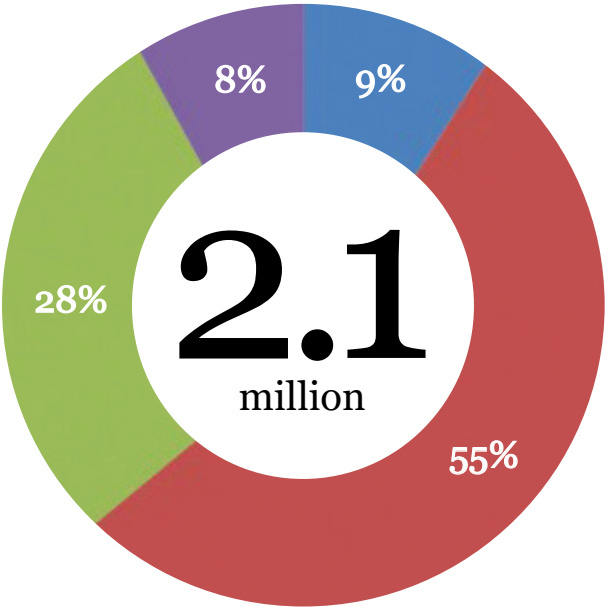

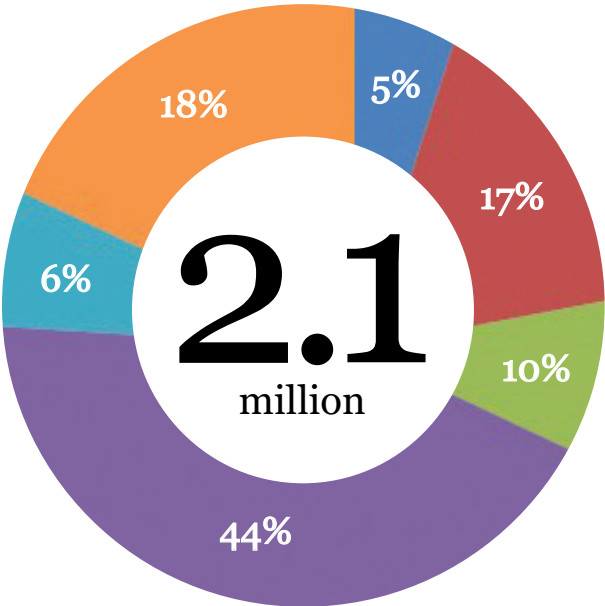

# Why I Give—Donor Stories

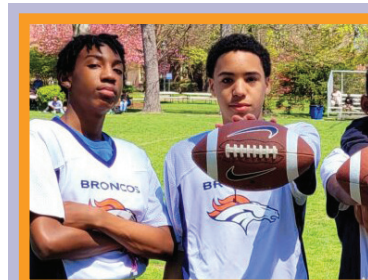

“For my senior project, I hosted an online fundraiser to raise money for San Miguel’s flag football team. San Miguel is a Lasallian middle school for boys in grades 5-8 from diverse and challenging backgrounds. I worked with both San Miguel and Soul Warming Fundraising, an organization that provides soups for schools and individuals to use to meet their fundraising goals. I posted the link to the fundraiser on my Instagram page and sent the link to family and friends. Through this fundraiser, we raised over \$400 for San Miguel’s flag football team. My aunt was so inspired by the project that she chipped in another \$350. Even though we did not reach my goal of raising \$1000, I still consider my project a success by the valuable lessons learned and the impact that San Miguel has had on my life since starting the project.”



“One day in the early 1940s my mother summoned me. She gave me two bags of food, and told me to bring them across the street to a neighbor who had three children and was without food. When the lady took the food, she was in tears and somehow managed to say thank you. My memory of this incident is imprinted on my mind due to the fact that at that time our family consisted of eight children and two parents. Later in life I was able to discern my mother’s concern for our neighbor. During my grammar school years, circa late 1930s and into the 1940s, the parents of my best friend Manny passed. The older brothers and sisters worked and my friend had to fend for himself. In those days, it was customary for students to return to their homes for lunch. # THE STAR CAMPAIGN

In early 2020, San Miguel launched a long-anticipated and carefully-scoped comprehensive campaign for support that we named The Star Campaign. The school's board of directors enthusiastically approved an ambitious goal of raising \$5M over three years in support of our evolving programs in learning support and mental health, some much needed building upgrades, including establishing a STEAM center to support 21st Century learning, and endowment for student sponsorships and graduate support.



Long-time supporters Ned and Polly Handy and Joe and Meredith MarcAurele (shown left) stepped up to the plate to lead the effort as the campaign co-chairs. About a dozen others enthusiastically joined them on the Campaign Committee which was tasked with connecting with donors and asking for support.

During the quiet phase of the campaign, donors gave generously and with purpose, cementing their commitment to Br. Lawrence's dream of providing an excellent educational option to those most in need now and into the future. Stories were told and tears of joy were shed as donors made their commitments. We were off to a great start!



Then March 2020 hit and the pandemic threatened the campaign's momentum. In a show of unwavering commitment and humble confidence, the committee voted to press on, determined to honor the campaign goal as well as the individual commitments that had been made to date. The future of the school could not wait, so the campaign steamed ahead. Work began in the summer of 2020 with needed improvements to the building including a new roof as well as new ventilation and sprinkler systems.

“Our new roof saves us from dodging leaks in morning assembly on rainy days! In addition, we are breathing healthier air from the new HVAC system, and, unseen but importantly, our building is well-prepared for fire emergency because of the new sprinkler system. Each of these great improvements have us poised for to serve the next generation of San Miguel Men.”

Things were cooking along...but by the end of the summer it had become clear that the pandemic had taken a major toll on our expense line with increased cost of almost all materials. Looking at the work that still needed to get done, the committee had to make another major decision—to raise the campaign goal to \$6M.





Meanwhile, the campaign had brought two new people into the building to provide student support, a part-time Learning Specialist in Kim Kimball and a full-time social worker in Kayla Farrell. Academic Dean, Carol Soltys, had long advocated for a learning specialist to provide support to teachers as they strove to meet every student’s academic needs. Kim’s work had an immediate impact.



“With Kim (Kimball) on staff, we have been able to close some academic gaps much more quickly. She works in the classrooms as well as pulls students out to work one on one or in small groups. The addition of her skills and expertise could not have come at a better time as so many students face learning loss due to covid.”

Kayla Farrell was hired as the school’s first full-time counselor, more than doubling our capacity in that area, and her social work degree enables her to provide professional support to families and graduates as well.



“Having Kayla on staff has significantly increased our ability to provide counseling services to our students, families and graduates. This new role has enabled us to provide services in a much more consistent way as well. It is so important for our graduates to be able to talk to someone they trust, so we have seen a lot of high school graduates return to the school to talk with Kayla.” -Taysha Paulo, Dean of Students

While Summer 2022 saw continued upgrades to some classrooms and offices, it also marked the crossing of the \$6M finish line! Raising a million dollars over the original goal, and a year early, is a massive accomplishment that was only possible thanks to all of you. Your generosity and commitment to this effort was, without a doubt, another San Miguel Miracle.

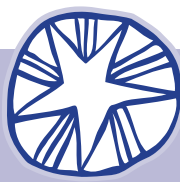
