**Columbus Public Health** is offering the COVID-19 vaccine at the Celeste Center (717 E. 17th Ave) with no appointment needed from 9:00AM-3:00PM on Monday, Thursday, Friday; from 9:00AM-1:00 on Saturday; from 11:30AM-3:30PM on Tuesday and Wednesday. Columbus Public Health (240 Parsons Ave.) is also offering walk-in appointments from 9:00AM-4:00PM on Monday-Friday. Vaccines are open to those 12 and up in Ohio.

Locally, **Lower Lights Christian Health Center** is administrating vaccines by appointment or walk-in inside the Mount Carmel Healthy Living Center at 777 W State Street.
