Public Comment Request: Zoning Code Changes

The City of Columbus has introduced a proposal to modernize the zoning on Columbus corridors. Through this code, the City aims to modernize zoning regulations to reflect our diverse community's evolving needs, support sustainable growth by improving transit options, expand housing opportunities and foster the development of job centers that will benefit all residents. The public comment period on these proposed changes is open until June 10th.

They've created the **Zone In Gallery** – an interactive space where you can learn all about the process at 141 N. Front St. – that will be open 6 days a week during the proposal's public comment period. Tours and appointments are available through June 7th.


