Free Services at the Hilltop Library

Legal Aid of Southeast and Central Ohio (LASCO) will be at the Hilltop Library (511 S. Hague Ave, 43204) the following Mondays from 4-6PM to answer questions. First come, first served. To receive free advice, you must have a gross household income at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level. Please be prepared to show proof of immigration status (if a non-citizen). Attorneys are available to answer questions only, and they will not attend court with you. If you have any upcoming court deadlines, you should contact Legal Aid Intake at 614-241-2001.

- **Monday, December 2nd Landlord/Tenant** (problems with housing conditions, eviction discrimination, retaliation)
- Monday, December 9th Family/Education Law (problems with IEP, enrollment, school removal, divorce, custody, child support, civil protection orders)

The Hilltop branch has multiple community partners offering additional **social services** at the branch, including:

- Southeast's Certified Healthcare Navigators offer free, unbiased help with enrolling and renewing Medicaid and Marketplace health insurance on Tuesdays from 12:30-4PM
- The Mid-Ohio Food Collective benefits team can help you apply for SNAP, Medicaid, and other health insurance benefits on the **second and fourth Wednesdays from 1-3PM**.
- The Columbus Financial Empowerment Center offers free 1-on-1 financial counseling on **Tuesdays from 1-6PM**.
