- Southeast Healthcare Navigators on first & third Thursdays 2-5PM: Free, unbiased help with enrolling and renewing Medicaid and Marketplace health insurance from Southeast.
- Mid-Ohio Food Collective Benefits and Customer Outreach on second and fourth Wednesdays 1-3PM: Learn and apply for SNAP, Medicaid, and other health insurance and benefits. They will answer questions about these programs and screen you for eligibility.

Financial LifeSkills Program


Get paid to learn money management! The 12-hour program is broken up into 6 classes:
