

# **ARGYLL GATHERING TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

## **NON REFUND POLICY**

Tickets will be refunded only in the case of the event being entirely cancelled. In this instance the face value of the ticket will be refunded. Please note, the tickets are for the event "Argyll Gathering" and not for the artists billed, therefore tickets will not be refunded in the event of one or more of the billed acts being cancelled. Tickets are issued subject to a license being granted by the local authority.

## **RIGHT OF ADMISSION RESERVED**

Argyll Gathering reserves the right to refuse admission to or to eject ticket-holders from the Event without a refund.

## **ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES, ALCOHOL & ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR**

Argyll Gathering has a zero tolerance towards illegal substances, underage drinking and anti-social behaviour. Anyone found with illegal substances or behaving in an anti-social manner will be ejected from the event site and reported to the police. Argyll Gathering encourages sensible drinking - please space out your drinks and consume plenty of water throughout the day.

## **UNDERAGE DRINKING**

All sales of alcohol are underpinned by a 'Challenge 25' policy. If you are lucky enough to look under the age of 25, you will be asked to provide identification. Please be aware that you may be asked to provide identification more than once (E.g Upon entry to the event, at the queue to the bars and at the bar itself). This This is a license requirement, so please bring an acceptable form of identification with you. It is illegal to sell to, purchase for or provide alcohol to anyone under the age of 18.

## **PROOF OF AGE – ACCEPTED FORMS**

Please note that the following examples of identification are the only ones accepted at this event. No other form of identification will be accepted, so please come prepared.

1. Valid EU Passport
2. Valid Driving Licence
3. PASS mark approved identification cards (<http://www.pass-scheme.org.uk/>)

## **LOST, STOLEN OR INCOMPLETE TICKETS**

Admission will not be allowed to persons presenting a ticket that has already been scanned or via tickets which have been recorded as lost or stolen.

## **LOST OR ALTERED WRISTBANDS**

Attendance without the relevant wristband issued by the event is not allowed and will result in ejection; wristbands that have been tampered with or removed will be declared invalid and lost wristbands will not be replaced.

## **ADULT TICKETS**

Your ticket will be exchanged for a non-transferable Argyll Gathering wristband at the event office when you arrive, which must be worn at all times. No one else can collect your wristband on your behalf, as only the Event Team will attach the wristband.

## **TICKETS FOR CHILDREN / YOUTHS**

Two type of tickets are available for those under the age of 16, Children's tickets (aged under 12 years) and Youth tickets (aged 12 -16). Either type of ticket is only available

with the purchase of an adult Ticket. One adult may accompany a MAXIMUM of 4 children/youths IN TOTAL (i.e .no more than 4 individuals under the age of 12).

Children's tickets (under 12) are complementary, however they must be booked in advance to ensure entry to the site.

### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. No person shall be permitted entry under the influence of alcohol or illicit substances.
2. No person shall enter the event with any item listed under the prohibited articles list.
3. All attendees are subject to the 'Challenge 25' policy and identification must be provided upon being requested.
4. All attendees are subject to the search policy. All bags are subject to search upon entry to the event.
5. No person shall carry any container of alcohol into the event.
6. No professional cameras may be brought into the event without express prior permission.
7. No person shall be permitted entry to the site if they are (at the time) on any locally operated pub watch scheme.
8. No football colours are permitted on the event site, along with any items of clothing bearing political statements.
9. All attendees must hold a valid ticket prior to entry. If purchasing a ticket at the event, then attendees must make their way through the box office to purchase one before entry can be granted
10. No goods or services may be offered (through literature, verbal or physical goods) on the event site without express prior permission.
11. CCTV systems may be in operation throughout the event site. Entering the event acknowledges this and attendees agree to the recording of their image for safety purposes only.
12. ARGYLL GATHERING RESERVES THE RIGHT FOR ITS AUTHORISED EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, CONTRACTORS AND POLICE OFFICERS ACTING REASONABLY TO REMOVE FROM THE GROUNDS (WITHOUT REFUND OR COMPENSATION) ANY PERSON WHO CONTRAVENES THE ABOVE 'CONDITIONS OF ENTRY' AND ANY PERSON WHOSE PRESENCE AND/OR BEHAVIOUR IN THE GROUNDS COULD REASONABLY BE CONSTRUED AS DANGEROUS, A NUISANCE OR ANNOYANCE TO ANY OTHER PERSON IN THE EVENT.

### **PROHIBITED ARTICLES**

- 1) Illegal substances and alcohol.
- 2) Flares, fireworks and pyrotechnics of any kind.
- 3) Anything that can be construed or purports to be a weapon.
- 4) Hard sided containers (i.e Picnic boxes, hampers, flasks)
- 5) Large banners, flags, rattles, klaxons or horns
- 6) Spray Paints
- 7) Laser Pens
- 8) Any wheeled footwear, skateboards and bicycles

### **NON LICENSED ALCOHOL ONSITE**

If you attempt to bring alcohol into the event arena it will be confiscated and you risk

being ejected from the event for breaching our licensing conditions.

No glass containers of any kind can be brought into the event area

### **FOOD & DRINK**

Whilst we do allow food into the arena, we cannot allow any liquids, in sealed containers or otherwise. We will allow babies bottles of milk.

### **ANIMALS**

Animals are not allowed into the event arena, with the exception of guide dogs.

### **LASERS/FIREWORKS/DRONES/ROVs**

Strictly no lasers, fireworks, drones or remotely operated vehicles of any kind are allowed anywhere on the event site. Those caught with these items will be removed from the site.

### **LITTER**

It is a beautiful site and as such, we wish to keep it as tidy as possible. Please use the bins provided.

### **NOISE WARNING**

Please be aware that there are specific locations within this event where the volume of music playing will be in excess of 95 dB (A weighted). It is recommended that those with small children come prepared with ear defence.

### **STROBE LIGHTING**

Please be aware that this event has lighting in operation with strobe effects, which may cause harm to those that suffer from epilepsy or photosensitive conditions.
