Rules and Regulations

1. Judges decisions are final.
2. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change order or divide classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
3. Courses will consist of post and rails, walls, gates, pickets and brush.
4. Championship and Reserve ribbons will be awarded in all divisions. Champion and Reserve will be awarded to two of the four horses which have acquired the most points in the over fence classes in their division. In addition to these points, only those horses shall receive full points for ribbons won in the under saddle classes. Points to be awarded through the first six places: 10-6-4-2-1-1/2.
5. A trophy and 6 ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise stated.
6. Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules and specifications of the current NEHC Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance there within.
7. **Warm-ups are \$20.00. You must have a number to go into warm-up.**
8. All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.
9. Returned checks are subject to a \$25.00 fee.
10. **Please - Keep dogs on a leash!**
11. Post entries will be accepted, but there will be a one time post entry fee of \$10.00/ horse for those not entered until the day of the show. no penalty fee will be charged for entering additional classes on the day of the show.
12. **All regular classes are \$20.00. All New Hampshire and Downeast Medal Classes are \$30.00. All NEHC Medal Classes are \$40.00.**
13. Footing: Warm-up and Competition Rings are all weather footing.
14. Ring dimensions: Ring 1 - 100' x 200' Ring 2 - 95' x 200'
15. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Suitable Hunter Division

Unrated. Open to beginning horses or riders of any age. Horse/rider combinations may not have competed over 2' at any previous show. shown over 4 to 8 fences not to exceed 18" with no combinations. May not cross enter into any division requiring horses to jump over 18" at the same show. May trot or canter fences. The under saddle class will be shown at the walk, trot, and canter with only 8 to canter at one time.

- 48. **NEHC English Pleasure Horse/Pony Class** – open to members and non-members of the NEHC. Open to all horses and ponies ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to the status of rider or place of residence. to be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Will be required to back. loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact, may be judged on manners, performance and quality in that order.
- 49. **Hunter Pleasure Under Saddle.** *Unrated.* to be judged at the walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. May be asked to hand gallop, halt and back. light contact with the horse's mouth is required, to be judged on performance, manners, quality, presence, suitability, substance and soundness.
- 50. **Hunter Pleasure Hack** – specifications to be the same as class #49.
- 28. **Open Leadline.** *Unrated.* open to riders 8 years of age and under. to be shown collectively at the walk and individually at the trot.
- 29. **Leadline Suitability.** same specifications as class #28.
- 30. **Walk-Trot Hunt Seat Equitation.** NEHC "C". open to riders 10 years of age and under. no child entered may compete in any other class requiring entries to canter. Rider must not have been judged in a class at a show that requires a canter. to be judged at a walk and trot both ways of the ring.
- 31. **Walk-Trot Beginners Pleasure.** NEHC "C". same specifications as class #30.
- 32. **Walk-Trot Hunter Under Saddle.** *Unrated.* to be judged as a hunter class. same specifications as class #30.
- 33. **Downeast Walk-Trot Poles Medal.** *Unrated.* open to riders 10 years and younger. Must not have shown over fences higher than 18". Contestants shall be required to show at a trot over a minimum of 4 rails (poles) on the ground. 25% of exhibitors, at least 2, shall be called back for individual testing. Verbal testing encouraged.

- 23. **Open Equitation – Flat** under 18. Walk, Trot, Canter. tests 1-19. NEHC "C" rated.
- 24. **Open Equitation – Fences** under 18. Fences not to exceed 3'. tests 1-19. NEHC "C" rated.
- 46. **Downeast Short-Stirrup/Long-Stirrup Medal** – open to Junior and Adult riders competing on horses or ponies. all ages (short and long stirrup) compete together at the qualifying shows, but age groups will be divided at the finals. Riders must not have shown over fences that exceed 18". Riders shall be required to perform a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence height will be 18". 25% of contestants, at least 2, may be called back for individual testing. testing optional, verbal recommended. USEF tests 1-8.
- 47. **New Hampshire 18" Novice Medal** – fences not to exceed 18". open to Junior and adult riders who have not shown over 18". Rider must accumulate 12 points to qualify for year end final. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. at least 3 riders must complete the course. testing is optional and at the discretion of the judge. USEF tests 1-18.
- 13. **New Hampshire Children's Medal** – fences not to exceed 2'6". open to Junior riders who have not shown over 2'9" at a recognized show. Rider must accumulate 12 points to qualify for year end final. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. at least 3 riders must complete the course. testing is optional and at the discretion of the judge. USEF tests 1-18.
- 8. **Downeast Modified Junior Medal** - open to riders 17 years of age and younger, competing on horses or ponies. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights will be 2'3". 25% of the contestants, at least 2, may be called back for individual testing. testing optional.
- 7. **NH Modified Children's Medal**- Fence heights not to exceed 2'3". open to Junior and amateur adult riders who have not shown over 2'6" at any recognized show. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change in direction. at least three (3) riders must complete the course. testing is optional and is at the discretion of the Judge. USEF test 1-18. note: when rider win medal class at year-end finals two years consecutively, the rider must move up to the NH Junior Medal or the NH adult Medal.

Special Children's/Amateur Adult Hunter Division

9. **New Hampshire Pony Medal** – fences not to exceed 2'3" for small and medium ponies and 2'6" for large ponies. Junior pony riders must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify for year end final. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. at least 3 riders must complete the course. testing is optional and at the discretion of the judge. USEF tests 1-18.
10. **Downeast Children's Pony Medal** - open to riders 17 years of age and younger, competing on ponies. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2' for small and medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies. 25% of the contestants, at least 2, may be called back for individual testing. testing optional USEF tests 1-8.
25. **New Hampshire Junior Medal** – fences not to exceed 3'. Junior riders must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify for year end final. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. at least 3 riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and at the discretion of the judge. USEF tests 1-18.
26. **Downeast Junior Medal** - open to riders 17 years of age and younger, competing on horses. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights not to exceed 2'9". 25% of the contestants, a minimum of 2 riders, may be called back for individual testing. testing optional USEF tests 1-19.
27. **NEHC Junior Hunt Seat Medal Class** – open to Jr. members of NEHC who have not reached their 18th birthday. all Contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. USEF tests 1-19. to fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. One win required to qualify for the finals.
12. **New Hampshire Modified Amateur Adult Medal** –fence heights not to exceed 2'3"-2'6". Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older who haven't shown over 2'6" at a recognized show in the current or previous 5 years. Rider must accumulate 12 points to qualify for the year end final. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. at least 3 riders must complete the course. testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF tests 1-18.

Unrated. Open to junior and amateur adult riders. Horse/rider combinations may not have competed previously in a class with fence heights greater than 2'6". Fences 2'3.

"Every entry at a recognized show shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that the person making it, along with the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider, and the horse: (1) shall be subject to the Constitution and rules of the Association and the local rules of the show; (2) that every horse, rider, and/or driver is eligible as entered;(3) that the owner and any of his representatives are bound by the Constitution and Rules of the NEHC and the show will accept as final the decision of the hearing committee on any question arising under said rules and agree to hold the show, the NEHC, their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken; (4) that the owner, rider/driver and any of their agents or representatives agree to hold the NEHC, the show, and their officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show, whether or not such injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the NEHC or show." Management reserves the right to decline or refuse any entry without being liable for compensation, and eliminate from further competition any exhibitor or horse should the best interest of the show be served. Every exhibitor or his agent and trainer must sign an entry blank. In the event of his failure to do so, his first entrance into the ring as an exhibitor shall be construed as his acceptance of the rules of the show involved and of the NEHC and shall ipso facto render him subject to said rules.

14. **Downeast Amateur Adult Medal** - Open to riders 18 years of age or older, competing on horses or ponies. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'6". 25% of the contestants, a minimum of 2 riders, may be called back for individual testing. Testing optional USEF tests 1-19. * Amateur Adult Medal Final is open to all Adults, even those who have previously won the medal final.
18. **New Hampshire Adult Medal** – fences not to exceed 2'9". Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older. Rider must accumulate 12 points to qualify for the year end final. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least 3 riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and at the discretion of the judge. USEF tests 1-18.
19. **NEHC Adult/Amateur Hunt Seat Medal** – open to amateur adult members of the NEHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3' with a combination and two changes of direction. One or more individual tests of the top 4 riders may be requested at the judge's discretion. To fill a class at least 4 competitors must complete the course.
