Township may enact an ordinance to opt in, or they may do nothing and not opt in. They pay attorney to regulate, and handle Public Safety and Building/Zoning issues.

Options are : Growers, Processors, Provisioning Centers, Safety Compliance Facilities, Secure Transporters.

Public comment: Community and family Impact, Financial Impact, Cannot be distributed through pharmacy, gateway drug, seed to sale tracking system, Still not to be used in public places, less caregivers, workers background check, banking and pay not through bank, accountability, not recreational, no clear pricing, benefit jobs, commercial tax base, what do you want town to be known for, state regulations include public hearings, illegal drugs available here 50 years, security, safe product
