

**Terms and Conditions**  
**unWINEd Riverina Promotion: VIP Meet & Greet with Daryl Braithwaite,**  
**February 2018**

1. Information on how to enter and prize(s) form part of these conditions of entry. By entering this competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
2. Entry is only open to Australian residents aged 18 years and over. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter and its agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, exspouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or first cousin.

For the purpose of this promotion, participating retailers will be any cellar door or retailer displaying material advertising this promotion during the Promotional Period.

To enter, individuals must complete the official entry form found in cellar door or retail premise with all required details including their full name, telephone number, a valid email address and tell us in 25 words or less what their favourite Riverina wine is and the best time to enjoy it by 11:59pm Tuesday 13.03.18.
6. By entering this competition you agree that you have read and understood the Riverina Winemakers data notification statement located at [unwinedriverina.com](http://unwinedriverina.com)
7. Incomplete, indecipherable, illegible or late entries will be deemed invalid.
8. Multiple entries permitted, subject to the following: (a) only one (1) entry permitted per Qualifying Purchase; (b) each entry must be submitted separately in accordance with the entry requirements; and (c) a maximum of five [5] entries per person per day is permitted.

Failure to produce the proof of purchase for all entries when requested may, in the absolute discretion of the promoter, result in invalidation of ALL of an entrants entries and forfeiture of any right to a prize. Purchase receipt(s) must clearly specify the store of purchase, that \$20 of Riverina wine was purchased, and that the purchase was made during the Promotional Period but prior to entry.
