In order to graduate from high school, consortium students are required to meet their resident school's graduation requirements. Open enrolled students are required to complete 24 credits. To ensure students are on pace for graduation, 10th grade students must take a minimum of six credits including 1 credit of English, Social Studies, Science, and Mathematics; a ½ credit of Physical Education and 1.5 elective credits. For consortium students whose resident district requires more than 24 credits for graduation or students who wish to complete high school in less than 4 school years, students will be required to take more than the 6 credit minimum with a maximum credit load of 8 credits per school year or 9 credits with administrative approval. In addition, all students need to complete 8 hours of community service per year.
