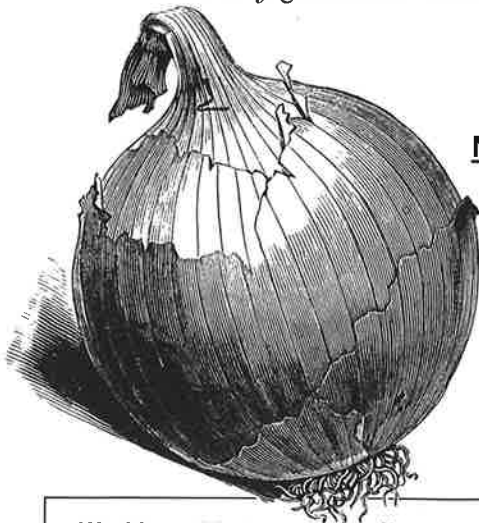
Located on 150 acres just north of Eugene, Groundwork Organics has been growing certified organic produce since 2000. Providing for restaurants and natural food stores in Eugene, Portland and Bend, and at seven farmers markets a week, we are dedicated to growing high quality fruits and vegetables year round. Our Community Supported Agriculture program (CSA) celebrates fifteen years this season, offering members easy access to our produce and a unique connection with the farm.

About our CSA

CSA members join the farm each year by paying up front for their share of produce. Every week during the season, produce is harvested fresh from the field, carefully washed, packed and delivered on Wednesdays for pick-up at neighborhood drop spots. We pack one size share, intended for a family of four, or two small households who arrange to split a box on their own. A typical box contains eight to ten items, seasonally changing but always well balanced.

We grow a wide variety of certified organic fruits, vegetables and herbs, including many heirloom and specialty crops. Several acres of coldframe greenhouses and well-drained soil help to ensure good variety throughout the season. Weekly newsletters are an important addition to the box, including notes from the farm, crop information and recipes. We also e-mail a proposed list of your upcoming box each Monday to help you plan ahead.

The annual fall CSA farm tour and pumpkin pick is a chance to visit the farm, learn a bit more about what we do, and enjoy time together. Over the years, the CSA has grown to become an integral part of the farm, connecting us with our community and providing crucial financial support early each season. In return, we offer members a very good value and the delicious experience of eating local.

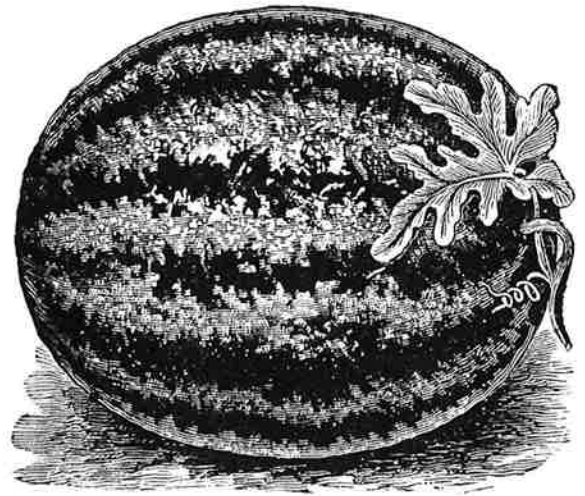

Specialties of the Farm

Not Just Vegetables We grow several acres of strawberries, as well as raspberries, blueberries, melons, grapes, apples, peaches and plums. Boxes include fruit many weeks out of the season.

Vacation Credit Take up to two weeks of vacation credit, to be used anytime at our market stands (credit given with a minimum of five days notice).

Market Stand Discount CSA members receive a 10% discount at farmers markets & the farm stand all year.

Full Season Shares

The full season includes six additional boxes in the spring featuring some of our most luscious crops including salad mix, spinach, carrots and radishes, basil, green garlic, spring onions, new potatoes and strawberries. Full season shares are available at all Eugene dropspots, Wednesday April 25 – November 14.

Market Cards

As an alternative to the CSA, market cards are convenient and offer a good value to customers who prefer to shop at farmers market. Pay \$90 for cards worth \$100 in produce from any of our market stands throughout the year. Pre-order cards using the registration form and we'll send them to you by mail, or purchase them anytime at market during the season.

About the Farm

After working for several years with experienced organic farmers nearby, Gabe and Sophie started Groundwork Organics in 2000. Our home farm is bordered on three sides by seasonal creeks, with the Willamette River just beyond. Beautiful sandy soil is the trade off for occasional winter flooding here. Unheated hoop houses help to extend our growing season, and allow us to provide for the area year-round. We also farm additional certified organic fields nearby, cultivating a total of about 150 acres.

With the help of an amazing crew, our produce goes directly to seven farmers markets a week, 350 CSA families, and some of the best restaurants and natural food stores in Portland, Eugene and Bend. Our farm stand, located on 60 organic acres just north of Eugene on River Road, offers u-pick berries and flowers, specialty items from our farm kitchen, and all-organic produce picked daily, Thursday thru Sunday.

Seeking out specialty and heirloom crops and focusing on soil health, fertility and innovative techniques, our customers have come to rely on us for a combination of quality and diversity that is hard to find. We take great satisfaction from growing beautiful produce, and bringing the bounty directly to you.

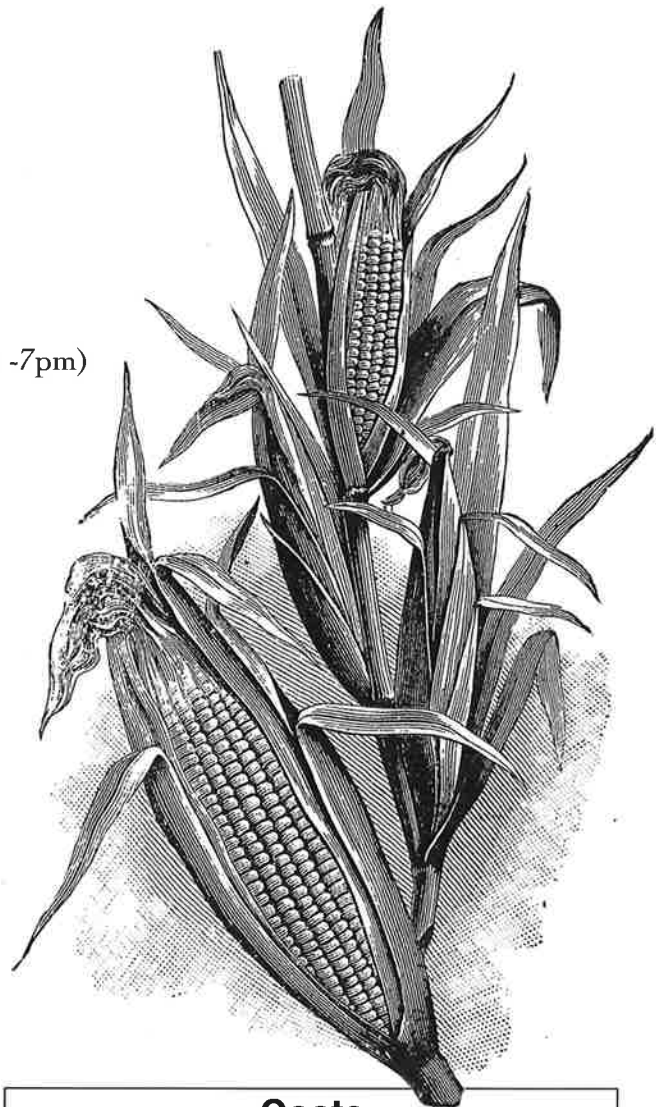
