Kits

The Fall Show offers two events that specialize in making and/or purchasing miniature kits. The first activity, Roundtables, is held on Friday, September 8th, 1:00 - 2:00 pm downstairs in the hotel's Magenta Room.

The second activity, Drop-In Workshops, is held on Saturday & Sunday during various times posted on the display located in hallway outside the Sales Room. Make it here or take it home. The instructors provide all tools & materials.

Both activities allow you to either join an instructor and make a kit or purchase a kit w/instructions to take home. Kits vary in price from \$5 to \$7 paid directly to the instructor.

Make an L-shaped “log” cabin. This year we are offering the workshop in three scales – 1”, ½” and ¼”. Please choose a scale when registering for the All-Day Workshop.

The 1” scale is 8” high, 9.75” long and 5.75” deep.

The ½” scale is 5” high, 5.37” long and 3.5” deep.

The ¼” scale is 2.5” high, 2.62” long and 1.62” deep.

You will stain the wood to build the walls of the log cabin on a foam core, construct and insert a window, and assemble a shelf or bookcase. You will score and stain the foam core for the “wood” floor and learn a technique for chinking and “log” wall. The side area could be a porch or a yard.

Specific tools and a supply list will be sent to registered students.

A quarter scale lighthouse on a rocky outcropping surrounded by ocean waves. A light house with a dubious reputation! Sometimes the light would mysteriously go out when a ship loaded with gold was caught in a storm --- only the light keeper knows why. Students will learn how to create ocean waves with spackle, how to create faux rock outcroppings with industrial ceiling tiles and pine bark. You will learn how to use a foam cutter, create foam shingles and stamping stonework into foam core along with lots of painting techniques and basic landscaping. This a great class to take for learning new techniques!

In this class you will be making a Christmas scene in Santa's hat to hang on the wall. Christmas provides so many possibilities for activities, from Santa's workshop to activities at your house. This workshop will consist of making and completing the hat itself. You will have the choice of white wallpaper or printed paper. The sample has been made as a toy store. Included in the kit is a piece of furniture along with instructions and materials for making small toys. There should be enough time in class to finish the toys. The tree is not included but a special gift under the tree is included with the kit.

Bring basic tool box kit, tweezers, tacky glue (for toys) and wall paper paste for wallpapering (or can use the glue), along with patience, as working with small beads can be challenging.

When you get your witch's hat home you can let your imagination soar, turning the room box into a potion room, a witches kitchen, a Halloween shop, whatever suits your fancy. Have fun.

Pat will provide the tea cups but if you have a tea cup of your own that you would like to use please bring it. You will also be given 6 more ¼" scale furniture kits that you can use for your enjoyment elsewhere.

Nancy Martin - 2023 Inspirational Miniature Artist

Hi, I'm Nancy Martin. I am very honored to be this year's featured artist for the 2023 Fall Show!

My enjoyment and appreciation of miniatures is definitely long term and lasting. Let me tell you my story.

As a little girl, as most children, I loved tiny things. I remember how thrilled I was to receive a small pink plastic tea set on a tray for Christmas. Then came grade school and Junior Garden Club. I made arrangements in tiny vases whenever I could.

I love all scales but, as many who run out of display room, I started going smaller and smaller. I was challenged every step of the way. I also collect dollhouses, room boxes, furnishings and accessories - new and vintage. I display them all over the house, even in the laundry room.

I belong to several miniature clubs of various scales both in Maryland & Colorado. I have learned so much sharing our hobby. Sharing our wonderful hobby is the BEST.

Here in Lakewood, I am very glad to be able to volunteer at the DMMDT and belong to more clubs! I feel I am learning more everyday and contribute to the museum.
