LENTEN REGULATIONS: Abstinence from meats is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on **Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent.**

Fasting is to be observed on **Ash Wednesday** by all Catholics who are 18 years of age, but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two small meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
