ARCHDIOCESAN EVENTS

Sacred Relics of The Saints: Treasures Of The Church Queen of the Holy Rosary Parish (7023 W. 71st Street, Overland Park) presents a teaching and exposition of Sacred Relics on Wednesday March 21 at 7:00 pm. Father Carlos Martins of the Companions of the Cross will be here with his very special ministry to teach about these holy objects. He will bring with him over 150 relics, some as old as 2000 years.

Among the treasures will be relics of St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the "Little Flower"), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. In addition, there will also be present a portion of the veil of Our Lady, as well as one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. In the Church's history many miracles and healings have been worked in the presence of relics, and many have been healed through this ministry. Please do not miss this opportunity. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession.

Confession Basics:

- Make the sign of the cross as you say, "Bless me Father, for I have sinned, it has been (*state how long since your last confession*) since my last confession, and these are my sins."
- Tell the Priest your sins.
- When you have finished confessing your sins, say, "For these and all the sins of my past I am truly sorry." The Priest will give you a suitable penance, and he may give you some advice.
- Make an act of contrition. "O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee. I detest all my sins because of Thy just punishments, but most of all because they have offended Thee, my God, who art all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace, to confess my sins, to do penance, and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen."
- The Priest will say the prayer of absolution. At the end of the prayer, say "Amen."
- The Priest will say, "Your sins are forgiven, go in peace."
- Then say, "Thank you Father."
- Perform the penance you were assigned by the Priest.
