

Signatures of those who will provide ongoing instruction (Form C)

The law requires the names, addresses, telephone numbers, and signatures of the persons who will provide ongoing instruction in each subject area of the minimum course of study § 166b(a)(6). This means someone other than the parent/guardian is providing all of the instruction for your child in a particular subject area such as Science or Math. This includes instructors such as:

- 1. A tutor, family member, or another homeschooling parent* who can provide one or more or all of the minimum course of study if you so arrange. *See definition of what "a home study program" is: 16 V.S.A. § 11(21)
- 2. An independent school teacher who is teaching a particular subject area at an independent school that you have enrolled your child in.
- 3. A public-school teacher at a local public school which would be paid for by the State. Your home study enrollment can only have up to 40% of the minimum course study taught by the public schools.

This is not required of the piano teacher, ice skating instructor, teacher/tutor of a short course or instructional opportunities that you use to enhance a subject are of the minimum course of study that you yourself teach.
