How to Enter: Complete and mail the entry/waiver and Release of Liability together with your \$125 entry fee to: Kamehameha Canoe Club - Hilo, 336 E. Palai Street, Hilo, HI. 96720. Checks should be made payable to Kamehameha Canoe Club – Hilo.

Deadline for entries and waivers:

Entry/waivers and release of liability forms, together with your entry fee must be received by Thursday, April 13, 2023. **Entries received after April 13, 2023 fees will be \$160. Entries received after April 17 will be at \$185. No entries will be accepted after April 20.**

All paddlers must fill out the individual HCRA waivers before they can enter the canoes for practice/race. Both adult and minor waivers are included. Please make copies as needed.

Mandatory Pre-regatta meeting:

A mandatory informational meeting for the representative from your business will be held at 5pm Friday, April 21 at Kamehameha CC – Hilo's halau. **Confirmation of team entries, divisions, and starting times will be made at this meeting. NO CHANGES WILL BE ALLOWED after Friday night.**

Practice begins on Monday, April 10 through Friday, April 21 from 4pm to 6pm. The practice site is at the Kamehameha CC – Hilo halau at the Suisan end of Hilo Bay. Because of the large number of entries expected, practice is limited to two (2) sessions per crew. EXPLANATION OF CATEGORIES

Business Men and Women: Each crew is allowed five paddlers and three alternates. Each person entering this Division must **NOT HAVE HAD **PRIOR PADDLING EXPERIENCE EVER, INCLUDING HIGH SCHOOL PADDLING.**** Steer persons will be furnished by KCC-Hilo and paddles are provided. **No personal paddles are allowed.**

Intermediate Men and Women: Each crew is allowed five paddlers and three alternates. A crew entered in this division may not use more than two persons who have paddled for a canoe club at any time within the last **seven years.** ****This division is also for new paddlers who are practicing with canoe clubs or sports groups.* We encourage those businesses that have been practicing for any longer length of time than the two weeks allowed for practice please enter this division.*** Steerspersons will be furnished by KCC-Hilo and paddles are provided. **No personal paddles are allowed.**

Open Men and Women: This event is open to everyone. Each crew is allowed six persons and two alternates. The crew may have its' own steersperson. **The open division is the only division allowed to use personal paddles during the race.**

Open Senior Mixed Masters: This event is open to all men and women 50 years and older. Each crew is allowed six persons and two alternates. The crew may have its' own steersperson. Each crew will consist of three women and three men.

Business Mix, Intermediate Mix, and Open Mix: In line with the rules above, each crew **must be made up of three women and two men, with the exception of Open Mix and Open Mix Senior Masters, which must be made up of three women and three men. A steersperson will be provided for the Business and Intermediate divisions.**

Open Mix Teens Divison: This event is open to all 18 and under boys and girls. The team must consist of three females and three males. All paddlers entered in this division must have age verification (photo copy of drivers license, school verification, or student ID) attached to parental or guardian signed waiver prior to race day. A copy for parental or guardian signature is enclosed. Please make copies for each of your teen paddlers.

***RACE OFFICIALS OF KCC-HILO RESERVE THE RIGHT TO RECATEGORIZE CREWS AND PADDLERS AS THEY DEEM APPROPRIATE.**

AWARDS: Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place crews in each event. Individual award ribbons will be given to each crew member for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place finishes in each event. We will allow the company to take the trophy with them for one year and we will put your name on the plaque but the trophy must be returned to KCC-Hilo before next years Business race.

IMPORTANT NOTICES

Please be sure to secure your drinking permits from the Police Dept. by Friday, April 21 prior to the Business race. KCC-Hilo will not be responsible for drinking at the beach. There may be a possibility of police patrol at the beach to check on drinking permits. Also, please remind your members that the beach area is a ***NON-DRUG, NON-ALCOHOLIC DRINKS & NON-SMOKING AREA.***

REMINDER

Please be sure that all paddlers on your crew fill out the individual HCRA waiver before they **enter any canoe for practice/race.** The combined adult and minor waiver is included. ***These forms must be turned in before the first practice.*** Please make copies for your crews.

Please remember that the informational meeting to be held on Friday, April 21 is **MANDATORY.** After Friday night, there will be **NO CHANGES ALLOWED!**

Parking: Designated parking stalls, grass area on highway okay. Grass area from inside gate to ditch must remain clear for Emergency vehicles.

REMINDER: ***Cars are not allowed in the gated area and the gate will be locked at 8am. If your car is inside of the locked gate, you will be locked in for the duration of the Business race. Please advise all of your members. Thank you for your cooperation.***

**Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association Insurance Program
Adult and Minor Waiver and Release of Liability
January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023**

Canoe Club:

Kamehameha CC - Hilo

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association and its member organizations' athletics/sports programs, and related events and activities, the undersigned:

1. Agree that prior to participating, they each will inspect the facilities and equipment to be used, and if they believe anything is unsafe, they will immediately advise their coach or supervisor of such condition(s) and refuse to participate.
2. Acknowledge and fully understand that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe social and economic losses which might result not only from their own actions, inactions or negligence, but the action, inaction or negligence of others, the rules of play, or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, that there may be other risks not known to us or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
3. Assume all the foregoing risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability or death.
4. Release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association, its member associations, its affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches, and other volunteers or employees of the organization, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and leasers of premises used to conduct the event, all of which are hereinafter referred to as "releasees", from demands, losses or damages on account of injury, including death or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasee or otherwise.

The undersigned custodial parent or legal guardian acknowledges that he/she is also signing this release on behalf of the minor participant, that he/she is waiving certain rights on behalf of the minor participant that the minor participant otherwise may have and that the minor participant shall be bound by all of the terms of this release. By signing this waiver and release without a parent's or guardian's signature, the participant represents he/she is at least 18 years of age, or, if signing as the parent or guardian of the participant, signer represents they are the custodial parent or legal guardian of the minor participant.

THE UNDERSIGNED HAVING READ THE ABOVE WAIVER AND RELEASE, UNDERSTAND THAT THEY HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT AND SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY.
