## Tis The Season!!

This is the season when powdery and downy mildew start to infect your plants in the garden and in your yard. This always happens in the summer when we get the heavy dews in the morning. In your garden you will see it on your cucumbers, melons, squash, and pumpkins. In your yard some of your perennials such as Bee Balm, Phlox, and on your shrubs especially lilacs. There are sprays that can be used to help control these diseases, but an ounce of prevention is the best way to fight it, once it gets to this point in the picture, its almost too late and the plants begin to die.

**Tomatoes** also are very susceptible to a number of different blights and mildews, so to keep your plants alive and producing tomatoes special care must be taken.
