



2018 Area IV NAYRC/CICOY Financial Agreement

The North American Junior Young Rider Championships (NAYRC/CICOY) will be held July 18-22nd, 2018 at The Event at Rebecca Farm in Kalispell, MT.

The NAYRC/CICOY expenses are estimated to be close to \$6,000 per rider for this seven day event. Riders are required to check in by Monday, July 16th and the competition ends on Sunday, July 22nd,

2018.

Each team is REQUIRED to have a USEA ICP Level III Certified Team coach. No other coaches are permitted. Our Area IV team will be coached by Allison Springer. Each team is REQUIRED to have a Chef d'Equipe. These expenses are included in the estimate of \$6,000 per rider.

Please sign below to acknowledge that you have been informed of the financial responsibilities of representing USEA Area IV at the 2018 NAYRC/CICOY North American Junior Young Rider Championships. Each rider and a legal guardian must sign. Submit the Signed Financial Agreement to the Area IV NAYRC Young Rider Coordinator by May 10th, 2018.

- Each rider is required to donate or fundraise a minimum of \$2,000 for the Area IV Young Rider Program. Funds must be provided to USEA Area IV no later than June 1, 2018.
- Each rider must obtain one product sponsor. Example- shirts, saddle pads, etc. for the full team.
- Each groom is required to donate or fundraise a minimum of \$500 for the Area IV Young Rider Program. Funds must be provided to USEA Area IV no later than June 1, 2018.
- **USEA Area IV is responsible for the cost of:**
 - Rider entry fee
 - 1 tack stall & 1 feed stall to be shared by all team members
 - Golf cart for the Area IV Coach and Area IV Chef d'Equipe
 - 3 Area IV Shirts, 1 Area IV hat and 1 Area IV jacket per rider
 - 1 food wrist band per rider, groom, Coach and Chef d'Equipe
 - Chef d'Equipe travel expenses and lodging
 - Area IV Team Coach travel expenses and lodging.
 - Area IV Coaching expenses for the duration of the competition (July 18-22)
- **Each Area IV Young Rider team member is personally responsible for the cost of:**
 - Any additional tack stall or feed stall that rider requests
 - Personal use golf carts if requested
 - Travel and living expenses
 - Meals outside of "wristband" meals provided by NAYRC
 - Additional dinner party tickets

- Incidental expenses
- Vet expenses for horse
- Farrier expenses for horse
- Shavings and horse feed
- Any expenses for stabling prior to July 16th (opening day of competition)
- Cost to attend mandatory Area IV Young Rider Camp and all travel expenses and stabling associated with Camp.

- **Each Area IV Groom is responsible for**

- Travel expenses and lodging
- Meals outside of “wristband” meals provided by NAYRC
- Grooms may be responsible for additional expenses if not enough funds are raised to cover them

I have been informed of the financial responsibility required to represent Area IV at the 2018 North American Junior Rider Championships & CICOY Championship in Eventing. I acknowledge the limitations financial responsibility for USEA Area IV and will not hold Area IV responsible for expenses incurred outside of those listed.

I understand that should there be an overall fundraising deficit, the cost to attend 2018 NAYRC could be up to \$10,000 as a Rider.

I understand that if there are 2 or less riders representing Area IV that Area IV reserves the right to NOT send a team.

I understand that ALL team riders are required to attend the training days scheduled in Montana prior to competition.

I understand that all fundraising requirements must be met by June 1, 2018 and are nonrefundable.

I have read and understand the 2018 USEF Selection Procedures, USEF Code of Conduct , USEA Area IV Selection Procedures, and USEA Area IV Selectors and Selection Trials. I have read and agree to abide by the Clean Sport and Anti-Doping regulations.
