**Welcome** to the South Star Recreation Trails.

This multi-use trail system is designed for non-motorized recreation. It is popular year-round with hikers, cyclists, skiers, snowshoers and equestrians. Please respect other trail users and private property owners and stay on designated trails.



**SOUTH STAR**  
TRAILS

These trails are managed in cooperation between Recreation Sites and Trails BC and the South Star Recreation Society. Established in 1979, these trails were developed under the integrated use concept of forest management. Timber, range and recreation development in the area is planned and undertaken to ensure all resources remain compatible, providing social and economic benefits to the residents of the East Kootenays. Between 2001 and 2003 this area was selectively logged for Pine Beetle control. In 2017 harvesting was done to create a fuel break for forest fire protection.

The South Star Recreation Society volunteers many hours designing, constructing, and grooming trails, maintaining facilities, and fund-raising for special projects. Membership is encouraged and can be purchased online from [www.southstartrails.com](http://www.southstartrails.com).

## Wildlife

- Be prepared to encounter wildlife. Please be respectful and keep your distance.
- During the summer months this area is used by ranchers to graze their cattle. Cattle can be encouraged to leave the trail by shouting.
- Please do not allow your dog to harass or chase the cattle or wildlife.



## Trail Etiquette

- \* Be aware - ski with care
- \* Skiers going downhill have the right of way
- \* When resting or visiting, please move off trail
- \* Avoid herringboning up the set track
- \* Snowshoers please restrict your use to the snowshoe trails. If necessary, stay off the set trail to link trails.
- \* During the ski season, dogs are permitted on K-9, Far East, Wapiti Way and snowshoe trails only.
- \* Please remove dog waste from the trail.
