

# Eye on Brooklyn

Those are some of the images in the exhibit "Intimate City: The Photographs of Thomas Roma," on view at the International Center of Photography.

Roma, a Brooklyn native, shoots the borough with the eye of a respectful, almost reverent son.

The five projects in the show all explore a different aspect of Brooklyn. They are "Higher Ground," photographs taken from elevated trains; "Sunset Park," shots from a neighborhood pool; "Found in Brooklyn," neighborhood studies; "Come Sunday," photographs of African-American churches, and "Court Portraits," shots of people in the hallways of the Brooklyn Criminal Courthouse.
