UEBT certification mark has 3 parts: fauna, flora, and people. The entire mark forms a circle representing our planet.

- 1 The leaf is an universal icon of plants and sustainability.
- The hands on each side represent people. Their position refers to protection and human care. It demonstrates respect and balance between all parts of the supply chain.
- 3 The outline reveals a feline referring to animals.
- The certification is awarded to companies whose sourcing systems have met strict standards for respecting people and biodiversity.
- Our tagline is what we promote. We guide on how companies and their suppliers should harvest, collect or grow natural ingredients in a way that contribute to a world in which people and biodiversity thrive.

The UEBT Certified label is awarded to companies that meet the criteria of the Ethical BioTrade Standard.
