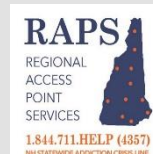




## Granite Pathways Regional Access Point Services



### As ChAARI Winds Down RAPS Comes to the Greater Monadnock Area

**WHO:** **RAPS** is a statewide initiative to assist New Hampshire residents struggling with substance use disorders to identify and access services to meet their needs. The **RAPS** program takes calls from the NH Statewide Addiction Crisis Line Monday through Friday 8am-11pm and Saturday and Sunday 11am-11pm. In addition to telephone support, **RAPS** offers:

**WHAT:**

- Screening
- Referral to evaluation
- Referral to Treatment
- Family Support
- Case Management
- Recovery Monitoring Services

**WHEN:**

As of June 1, 2018, the ChAARI phone line will be transitioned to the NH Statewide Addiction Crisis Line. The confidential Crisis Line is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and has trained counselors that are there to help. These calls are referred to RAPS specialists who will provide individually tailored services as described in “WHAT” above.

**WHERE:**

**RAPS** has an office in Keene at Southwestern Community Services, 63 Community Way, Keene, NH and is available to see clients face to face on Wednesdays between 9am and 2pm (more hours coming soon).
