OUR WEEK OF LEARNING

Math- Students will begin finding hidden partners within circular and scattered dot configurations with the numbers 3-5. They will model decompositions of 3 with materials, drawings, and expressions. Students will understand the concept of zero and work with numbers 0-5. We'll be writing numerals 0-3 to answer *how many* questions.

Science: We will discuss the sun's effect on the earth. Students will add sunscreen to their previously made mystery bead bracelets to see what happens and continue to learn about the sun through discussions and books.
