- II. Kate and Greg reported on TL CBD Board feedback that compliance with Brown Act should be maintained, ie posting notice of meeting and agenda in advance, approving Minutes from previous meeting, etc.
- III. Amy Cohen, OEWD, scheduled to speak on Public Spaces was unable to attend
- IV. Kate and Greg gave the following updates:
  - a. Hyde/Turk Park - CBD is work with Friends of Turk Hyde Park and other community partners towards activation of the Park. MOU between CBD and Parks & Rec is being reviewed, and an Advisory Committee is being formed.
  - b. Safe Passage and the CBD participated in Sunday Streets on 4/30. Ellis Street was quite active, much interest in SP was generated with approx. 70ppl signing up to receive information on volunteering.
  - c. Safer Taylor Street - update that the CBD hosted MTA's Planning Kickoff for this project, including a Corner Captain escorted walk of the Taylor Street area
  - d. Hellman Foundation Grant - Kate reported that the CBD had applied for a grant from this Foundation which would be for capacity building and would include the Turk Hyde Park pilot program.
  - e. Kidpower Train the Trainer Training
- V. Greg gave brief overview of latest UCSF Student Project - 2 Year Population Health Assessment
- VI. After discussion of possible outreach to neighborhood schools currently not participating in Safe Passage, Sonja from Salvation Army volunteered to contact both organizations towards developing a relationship.
- VII. Kate announced that TLCBD Board is seeking candidates for next month's elections.
- VIII. New business/announcements: Greg relayed that he had met with Veterans organization Swords to Plowshares, and will begin active recruiting efforts of Veterans at 2 of their residential facilities in the next few weeks.
