I. Block by Block Update

a. Update on Operations

E. Morales gave an update on maintenance operations for the month of June. Items discussed included monthly statistics, hot spot responses, and a special district graffiti detail.

II. Downtown Streets Team Update

a. Update on Operations

B. Davis gave an update on the work conducted by the Downtown Streets Team including monthly statistics and employee transition updates. Downtown Streets Team will be holding a Tenderloin launch picnic on July 17th at Boeddeker Park from 11:30am-1pm.

III. TL Clean Program Concept

a. Larkin Street Corridor- add two day a week of pressure washing

S. Gibson discussed a pilot project for the Larkin Street corridor that would increase the level of maintenance for 60 days to make a difference to the environment. The pilot concept would include, 2 times a week pressure washing, daily graffiti removal, an increased clean team sweeper focus, and 6 added trash receptacles. S. Gibson distributed a budget provided by Block by Block to add the 2 additional days of pressure washing using the existing equipment. The estimated cost is \$10,000 for the 60-day pilot program which would begin on August 1. PROW Committee approved the item moving to the Board for approval.
