



Tenderloin Safe Passage
Committee Meeting Minutes - APPROVED/FINAL

- I. Introductions – Kate opened the meeting and welcomed all
- II. July Meeting Minutes were approved
- III. Kate gave updates on following:
 - a. Back to School – afternoon shifts had resumed, though owing to manpower required for Park shifts, had not been able to have Roaming Team
 - b. TL Community School – relationship with TL school was developing, with Greg tabling during 1st week of school, meeting Principal & securing invitation to her Friday Coffee time with parents the following week. Kate attended the Coffee Time. Progress!!
 - c. Hyde/Turk Park – Park shifts & activation activities are continuing. Number of kids in Park has declined since school term started – to be expected. Number of adults in Park & participating in activities has increased. Success!
 - d. Safer Taylor Street – Tactical Urbanism event was a big success. A LOT of work, particularly for closing crew who helped MTA staff with breaking down, moving plants to Boedekker, etc.
 - e. Safe Routes to School – Kate & Greg will be meeting with Ana Validzic to develop strategy to begin SRTS work.
- IV. Financials/Grants –
 - a. Kate reported on receiving an In-kind \$5,000 Azure grant from Microsoft due to efforts of summer interns. This will help with maintenance of new database app.



- b. Greg talked about an RFP he would be writing for a DAAS Community Services grant which would include funding for Safe escorting.
 - c. Greg reported that the 2017-18 Vision Zero grant RFP would be coming out later in the month, and he would be writing for it.
 - d. Safe Routes to School funding for 2019-21 hasn't been finalized, is still being discussed by MTA Commissioners.
 - e. Fundraiser was discussed and all agreed event should be postponed till Spring.
