RE: Removal of tree branches and debris

The City of Havre is currently in the process of clearing the streets and removing the debris from boulevard trees throughout the city. We will be clearing the priority/emergency routes first and working our way through town as quickly and efficiently as possible.

If you have branches and debris from your yards we would ask that you DO NOT put it on the boulevards or in the alleys at this time. It also is very important that branches are NOT placed on the city streets. Our main priority at this time is to be able to clear the streets and provide safe travel throughout our city and safe bus routes for our students.

The City of Havre is currently working on locations where debris can be disposed of. As soon as it is dry enough, the Northside tree dump will be open and available for homeowners to dispose of their branches. We will continue to update you on further developments on locations.
