POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Education Specialist will assist the S2C Program Director to coordinate and supervise homework assistance and tutoring services provided by our team of tutors. The Education Specialist will be the primary liaison with the participants' schools to ensure that we receive the necessary information to support academic requirements and to build effective relationships. The Education Specialist will also provide direct training to students in our skill-building curriculum, Self-Regulated Executive Functions (S-REF). Responsibilities include:

- Lead strategy sessions through the School 2 Career skill-building curriculum, Self-Regulated Executive Functions (S-REF). Prepare weekly lesson plans according to the School 2 Career (S-REF) curriculum.
- Develop academic seminars such as goal setting and study skills.
- Develop tutor training materials. Monitor tutoring session instruction and outcomes.
- Assist with program development and implementation.
- Track the progress of each student and review with the Program Director to organize instructional efforts.
- Distribute announcements, brochures, and other materials to students.
- Review copies of student report cards for each report period, compile the data, and determine strategies to assist students to meet academic goals.
- Contact schools to establish contact person for assignments, reports cards, and test scores when necessary.

- Maintain S-REF (S2C curriculum) data, progress assessments, and report cards for students.
- Attend S2C events and tours when necessary.
- Develop and review Individual Improvement Plans (IIPs) for students and identify activities and lesson plans to improve academic performance.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Bachelor's degree is required, PA teaching certification preferred but not required.
- Must be familiar with high school PA Core standards.
- Excellent communication (verbal and written) and organizational skills.
- Strong leadership and interpersonal skills.
- Exhibit strong classroom management skills.
- Must have a warm and friendly personality.
- Must be able to relate well to high school youth and demonstrate cultural competence.
- Demonstrate a willingness to fulfill responsibilities in accordance with the School 2 Career Program mission and vision.

Additional Information: Education Specialist must pass all post-offer, pre-employment criminal background checks prior to hire, and candidate must be able to pass all additional clearance requirements as mandated by school districts and state/local municipalities.

Compensation (Exempt employee)
