



2017 LIST CHANGES

**** This is a just a summary of some of the changes made this year. It is still your responsibility to read and review the premium book for all rules and regulations****

1. Junior Market Cattle Entry Deadline Change from October 31st to August 31st to align with DNA Deadline
2. Junior Heifer Entry & Ownership Deadline Change from October 31st to November 15th.
3. Junior Prospect Cattle Entry & Ownership Deadline Change from October 31st to December 1st.
4. Junior Breeding Ewe Entry & Ownership Deadline Change from October 31st to November 15th.
5. Junior Breeding Gilt Entry & Ownership Deadline Change from October 31st to December 1st.
6. Junior Showmanship Entry Deadline Change from October 31st to December 1st to align with Breeding Gilt deadline change.
7. Club Calf and Sun Classic Heifer Entry & Ownership Deadline Change from November 15th to December 1st.
8. Added an Early Bird Animal Health Check-in on December 26th from 2:00pm-8:00pm for \$500 per trailer, this can be paid for online when completing your online entries. Deadline to register for this will be December 20th.
9. Added a fee schedule for Incomplete and/or Late DNA Samples/Entries as follows:
 - a. 1-7 Days after deadline \$250.00 per DNA Sample/Entry
 - b. 8-14 Days after deadline \$500.00 per DNA Sample/Entry
 - c. 15+ Days after deadline up to check-in closing \$1000.00 per DNA Sample/EntryAll ownership deadlines will apply and must provide proof of ownership.
10. Release will only be allowed between the hours of 6:00pm-8:00am each day. Release forms must be obtained from department superintendents prior to each day's release time window.

11. Cattle Blocking Chute permits price increased from \$20 to \$35 and from \$30 to \$50 for late purchases.
12. Sheep/Goat Barn – Tack space will be limited. We will be selling tack space in this barn. If sold out then exhibitors will need to groom outside.
13. Swine Barn – All tack must be kept off the floor and out of aisle ways. Tack can be stored above pens on surface provided by ANLS.
14. Dogs will no longer be allowed on show grounds. They can be kept in RV area, on leashes only.
15. No outside golf carts, gators, scooters, etc. will be allowed on grounds
16. Feed Store will only be selling straw, hay and shavings. No outside shavings will be allowed.
17. ANLS Club will now be open to everyone. There will be a discount offered to members.
18. Cattle Tuberculosis - All cattle three (3) months (CHANGE FROM 2 MONTHS TO 3 MONTHS) of age and over must be tested negative for Tuberculosis within sixty (60) days prior to arrival at the Show. Breeding beef cattle (bulls and females) from an accredited Tuberculosis free herd or a Tuberculosis free state, and steers are exempt from the Tuberculosis test requirement. If from an accredited Tuberculosis free herd, the Herd Accreditation Number and last herd test date must be shown on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.
19. Swine CVI – CVI must be issued within 10 days of the show. This is a change from 30 days prior to 10 days prior to show.
20. Swine CVI – CVI must list statements stating the swine have not been fed garbage and that they have not been vaccinated for Pseudorabies.
21. Addition of \$500 premium for Champion Sun Classic Heifer.
22. Increased Premium to \$1000 for Champion Club Calf Pen, increased premium to \$300 for Reserve Champion Club Calf Pen.
23. Added premium of \$500 for Champion Individual Club Calf.
24. Club Calf/Sun Classic – Animal purchased by exhibitor will have opportunity to participate in a Futurity Class held in conjunction with Sonoita SAILA show later in the year.
25. Open Cattle & Open Sheep – No entry fee for group class entries (animals have to be entered in individual classes with entry fees to be eligible for group classes)

26. Open Cattle & Open Sheep – Substitution Fee Change. Up through December 15, \$25. After December 15th through end of Check-in, \$100.
27. Open Sheep – Addition of Wether Dam Sale.
28. Junior Entry Fee Increase: (Page 79)
 - a. Junior Sheep – From \$25 to \$30 per entry
 - b. Junior Swine – From \$25 to \$35 per entry (will include initial bedding)
 - c. Junior Goats – From \$25 to \$30
 - d. Junior Cattle – No Increase
 - e. Junior Heifers – No Increase
29. Added Ring of Honor Award calculations to the rule book.
30. Combined Prospect Feeder and Prospect Market Steers; all steers will show together.
31. Added Prospect Heifer Division.
32. Added Premiums for Junior Market Cattle
33. Added \$1500 premium for all Grand Champion Market Animals
34. Changed name of Gilt Sale from Grand Canyon Classic to Arizona National Gilt Sale
35. Added Junior Division to Master Showmanship.
36. Late Fee change for Judging contest
37. Poster contest updated to state that poster must be received in office at time of entry
38. Late Fee change for Skill-A-Thon
39. Added buckle and \$200 premium for High Individual in all 3 divisions of Skill-A-Thon
40. Best of Show Ag Mechanics project to be sold through Sale of Champions, making this mandatory to sell.
41. Ag Mechanics entry fee changed to \$5 per entry for unlimited entries.
42. Ag Mechanics sale commission changed to 10%.
43. Ranch Replacement Heifers can enter pens of 5 or 10, as well as 3. Entry fees for pens of 5 or 10 are a reduced rate to promote larger pens.
44. Ranch Replacement Heifer sale commission change from 7% to 5%.

45. Ranch Horse – Updated Jackpot payout to allow 4th place horse to receive payout as well.
46. Pattern updated for Ranch Horse Competition
47. Only animals allowed to consign to packer are animals that compete in the Junior Market Divisions.
48. Decrease the number of animals sold through the Junior Livestock Auction to make it a Sale of Champions. Mandatory for only breed/division champions, breed/division reserve champions, grand and reserve grands, as well as Best of Show Ag Mechanics. No other animals/lots will be allowed to sell. Total Lots through the Sale of Champions will be 43.
49. Sale of Champions to move to 4:00pm on December 31st.
