List of Clothing and Other Articles

Boarders

Dressing appropriately is a necessary part of education. Students are encouraged to wear simple, practical clothes; clothes in which they can participate in all the school activities and sit comfortably, cross-legged, on the floor. Our stress is on simple clothes, suitable for all occasions. We do expect students to conform to prescribed uniforms in school, at P.T. and games and in the evenings.

The school is a place of learning. Contemporary fashion dictates, be it tight revealing clothes, use of gel, deodorants, make up, long hair, fashionable hairstyles such as crew cuts, Mohawk cut etc, earrings for boys, and such like are not considered suitable school wear and are discouraged. Students are

- NOT allowed to wear sleeveless dresses in school.
- NOT allowed to wear tight or revealing clothes in school.
- NOT allowed to wear dresses made of transparent material in school.

Parents are requested to ensure that all the items as per the list prescribed are provided, as they have been drawn up after careful scrutiny of the needs of the students. It is also essential that the student's personal number or initial be marked on each and every item on the list, preferably by embroidering.

Please note :

1. Skirts and shorts should cover the knee and not be shorter.
2. The number of dresses for the week end should not exceed the numbers specified in the list.
3. Wherever the item gets repeated in the list the quantity is not mentioned.
4. Please note that students are
NOT allowed to bring ANY KIND OF ELECTRONIC ITEMS including mobile phones, music players, cameras, costly watches, etc to school.
NOT allowed to bring any CASH to school.
NOT allowed to bring any food items from home to school.
