<u>II.</u>	Other 1	<u>Provisions</u>
	a)	All toys and clothes belonging to the children shall travel freely between households and shall be returned with the children in a clean and orderly manner.
	b)	The custodial parent shall ensure that the non-custodial parent has the opportunity to spend a portion of Winter Break, Thanksgiving and the child(ren)'s birthday with the child.
	c)	Parents are allowed to deviate from this schedule by mutual agreement and should do so when it is in the best interests of the child(ren) or circumstances necessitate.
	d)	It is important to be aware that this visitation schedule is for the purpose of providing assured minimum amounts of visitation between non-custodial parent and child.
		Visitation should exceed the number of occasions set out herein, if appropriate.
