Call for Proposals for Innovative Grant- Up to \$10,000 Available

<u>HHRF announces a request for proposals for an innovative grant. Up to</u> <u>\$10,000</u> is available to be awarded. We are looking for game-changing, innovative, and disruptive ideas that will lead to new equipment, processes, or services and could be a steppingstone for future research.

The goal of this grant is to connect practice with scientific knowledge by supporting innovative research with high-impact potential that might not be funded through traditional channels. Our intent is to stimulate exploration, encourage the testing of hypotheses, and generate preliminary data that will open new pathways for future research.

HHRF wants projects that will build research and the profession of Equineassisted Services (EAS). The board will be asking the top tier applicants to present a slide deck to them as part of the process.
