

PRIVACY POLICY

PLEASE READ THIS PRIVACY POLICY CAREFULLY BEFORE USING THIS WEBSITE.

GENERAL

CORE Media and/or its parent companies, subsidiaries, agents or affiliated companies (collectively, "CORE," "we" or "us") owns, operates and/or provides this and other websites, applications, pages on social networks (e.g., Facebook, Twitter, Instagram) and other online or wireless services (each, a "Website" and collectively, the "Websites"). By accessing and/or using the Websites, you agree that both your access to and use of the Websites are governed by this Privacy Policy.

INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We collect personally identifiable information (such as, your name, mailing address, e-mail address, telephone number, birth date or gender), when it is voluntarily submitted by users in connection with feedback, registrations, surveys, memberships, products or services. Please note that participation in some activities offered on our Websites may be limited without the submission of personally identifiable information of the user.

We collect aggregate information about your activities on our Websites (such as, pages at the Website which you access most frequently, what browser version you are using, what browser plug-ins you have installed, etc.). This allows us to improve our Websites based on current technology demographics so that we may provide you with the best online experience at the Websites. The only time we ever receive personal information from you is when you volunteer the information. The personal information we receive from a user-submitted entry for a registration, survey, product or service may be shared with that registration, survey, product or service's third-party promotional partners if the user has given us permission to do so. Users may elect not to participate by clicking the appropriate on-screen checkbox before submitting any information.

COOKIES

A "cookie" is a small data file that is sent to your computer when you visit a website. Cookies are stored on your computer's hard drive. Cookies allow the website to remember information that can enhance your visit. We use cookies to provide features such as auto-login and to determine when you have previously visited our Websites. Our cookies are not used to retrieve any information from your computer that was not sent to you by us. Our cookies do not contain any personally identifiable information about you. Most Internet browsers are set up to accept cookies, most browsers allow you the ability to reject cookies or prompt you when cookies are being used. However, if you choose to set your browser to reject cookies you may lose some functionality on our Websites, such as auto-login.

THIRD PARTIES

At times, we hire third party vendors to provide services such as creating our Websites, ads, promotions, and other marketing materials. These third parties may collect data from our Websites through cookies and the registration process. This data may be used to develop reports on how to make the Websites more interesting and useful.
