

MAKE SURE TO BRING...

Conference items

- o Qur'an (optional)
- o Notebook
- o Pen/pencils
- o Recording device for lectures (optional)

Clothing for 7 days

All clothing MUST be Islamically appropriate, i.e. loose and covering

- o Casual clothes
- o Pajamas
- o Clothes for fajr
- o Extra socks
- o Sweat shirts
- o "Outdoor" clothes (sports, hiking, etc.)
- o Shoes for hiking and sports
- o Clothes to wear swimming (sisters and brothers will go swimming separately, but please still bring something that is Islamically appropriate, in case we are unable to cover the fence around the pool)
- o Warm clothes!!!! Be sure to check the weather.

✓ *IT MAY BE MUDDY! An Extra pair of shoes is a good idea.*

Bathroom items

- o Soap and Shampoo
- o Toothbrush and toothpaste
- o Deodorant
- o Brush/comb
- o TOWELS!!
- o Other toiletries (i.e. Contact lens solution)

Misc. Items

- o Slippers for bathroom
- o Flashlight with fresh batteries
- o Camera (optional)
- o Tissues/Kleenex
- o Sleeping bag, pillow and blanket.

ALL CELL PHONES will be turned over to counselors and may only be used at pre-determined times at the *counselor's* discretion, and will be returned at end of camp

DO NOT BRING...

- Weapons of any kind*
- Drugs of any sort. *
- Any MP3, I-pod, or music device.
- Handheld video games (eg. Gameboy or PSP's)
- Irreplaceable valuables (inherited jewelry, family heirlooms, etc.)

*Anyone who brings these items is subject to immediate removal from the camp

***NOTE TO THE BROTHERS:** If you bring shorts, they must be Islamically appropriate (i.e. covering the knees even when bending.) Also, make sure you bring pajamas. Sleeping in boxer shorts will not be tolerated.

***NOTE TO THE SISTERS:** Islamic dress code applies to all participants for the duration of the camp. Hijab must be worn at all times, except in your designated cabin.
