PERIODIC TABLE OF THE ELEMENTS COLLECTION!!!



Description: A handsomely-displayed collection of 25 generous and purposely varied samples in an attractive and sturdy black gem case. Nearly all basic elemental groupings are represented in this collection: the transition metals, the alkalis, metalloids, non-metals, platinum group and rare earths. They are virtually all 99%+ in purity. Row one includes Nickel, Cobalt, Iron, Cadmium, and Antimony. Row two features Magnesium, Zinc, Tungsten, Copper, and Manganese. Row three has Carbon, Gold, Silicon, Platinum, and Aluminum. Row four contains Silver, Lead, Samarium, Bismuth, and Indium. And row five consists of Gallium, Tin, Sulphur, Chromium, and Calcium. Each element case has a nice label on the bottom. This set measures 7 1/2" x 8 1/2" x 2". (Estimated value = \$150+)

Eligibility: One Grand Prize ticket will be distributed for each **paid** entrance into the show. (Children 12 and under are NOT eligible for this drawing.) It is the responsibility of the attendee to write their **name, phone number, and email** on their ticket and to deposit it into the collection box located at the far end of the Upper Deck area.
