## SABRE-TOOTH TIGER SKULL (REPLICA)!!!



**Description:** Extinct for thousands of year, the saber-toothed tiger, or *Smilodon Fatalis*, was a predatory mammal characterized by long, curved saber-shaped canine teeth. The large, maxillary canine teeth extended from the animal's mouth even when it was closed. This 1:1 detailed replica of a fossilized sabre tooth tiger skull is hand-cast directly from an original and made from quality hand-finished designer resin. The sabers are complete and the casting process captured the nasal cavity as well as the cavities where the sabers go. It is hand-finished to replicate fossilized bone. (Estimated value = \$50)

**Eligibility:** One Grand Prize ticket will be distributed for each **paid** entrance into the show. (Children 12 and under are NOT eligible for this drawing.) It is the responsibility of the attendee to write their **name, phone number, and email** on their ticket and to deposit it into the collection box located at the far end of the Upper Deck area.
