REGISTRATION: Email the Event Chair (tori@apprenticeshop.org) with the following information or send in the attached form.

-Name of Club/School/ Organization

-Coach/Advisor/Parent's name and contact information (phone and email)

-Names of sailors and position (skipper, crew A or B) and age.

-\$10/pp (includes swag) and BBQ).

FORMAT: A/B Fleet Racing. Two fleets: Optimist, 420s. The fleets will be scored separately and not combined.

A 420 team consists of a minimum of 4 sailors. An Optimist team consists of a minimum of 2 sailors. Clubs can enter multiple teams in a fleet at the discretion of the race organizers.

RULES: RJR will follow US Sailing/IYRU guidelines, unless otherwise indicated in the Sailing Instructions. Races are scored on the low point system.

SAFETY: USCG Approved Type III PFDs are mandatory for all participants. A coach or other team representative must be present at all times. Emergency contact information for every sailor must be in the possession of the team's coach or other adult representative.

LUNCH: Sailors should bring a lunch to eat of the water. There will be no break for lunch.

BBQ AND AWARDS: During the BBQ after the races, Awards will be announced. The Red Jacket Regatta presents a Sportsmanship Award, Coaches Award and 1st, 2nd and 3rd place team awards for all fleets.

LOCATION/DIRECTIONS: 655 Main Street Rockland, ME 04841. Rockland Community Sailing is an Apprenticeship program. We sail in Rockland Harbor in view of the Lighthouse and Breakwater. Heading north on RT 1 we are just past Dunkin Donuts on the right. Heading South on RT1, we are just past Claws on the left.

Waiver of Liability: Sailing is an activity that has inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating at entirely their own risk. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host organization, sponsors or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property, or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release race organizers from and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

Right to Use Name and Likeness: By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
