Open Letter to Olaf Scholz, Chancellor of the Federal Republic of Germany

1 November 2022

Re: Your Visit to Beijing

Dear Chancellor Scholz,

We, the undersigned human rights non-governmental organisations, are writing to urge you to reconsider your visit to Beijing in November 2022.

The timing of this visit would coincide with the start of Xi Jinping's third term as Secretary General of the Communist Party of China (CPC). His previous two terms have been marred by an exponential growth in gross and widespread human rights abuses within the People's Republic of China, combined with active efforts to undermine the international rules-based order and restrict fundamental freedoms around the globe.

His current legacy includes ongoing atrocity crimes in the Uyghur Region (Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region by the Chinese government) - which the Office of the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights has said could amount to crimes against humanity and termed as tantamount to violations under international criminal law - the crackdown in and overturning of Hong Kong's constitutional order, the ongoing crackdown in Tibet, continuous and mounting threats of a military invasion of Taiwan, and his unrenounced partnership "without limits" with Russia.

In this ambit, the CPC would most certainly use your first visit to the PRC for propaganda purposes, promoting a narrative of endorsement following its 20th National Congress. The invitation of a German trade delegation to join your visit will be viewed as an indication that Germany is ready to deepen trade and economic links, at the cost of human rights and international law.

Only last month, the German Government stood with its democratic allies at the UN Human Rights Council in support of a resolution to discuss the UN OHCHR's findings in its Uyghur report. A request that was defeated in a show of the PRC's growing global authoritarian influence. The above propaganda narrative will further contribute and legitimise that influence in signalling that no real cost will be imposed.

It is our firm conviction that this runs counter not only to the universal rights of those suffering at the hand of the CPC inside - and increasingly outside - China, but also to the fundamental long-term interests of Germany and the European Union as a whole.

The European Union's foundational values are built on human rights and fundamental freedoms. A rapidly growing consensus among democratic nations - and allied partners - recognizes the severe threat the PRC poses to these values and the need to rapidly reduce economic

dependence to bolster democratic resilience. This cannot be achieved by loosening economic dependence on one authoritarian power only to deepen economic dependence on another.

Your visit at this time would send a most distressing signal of democratic disunity in the face of the PRC's growing authoritarian behaviour around the world and further embolden its aggressive commitment to substitute the international rules-based order with its repressive governance model.

We therefore call upon you to urgently reconsider your visit. This would send the clearest signal that Germany, as one of the leading members of the European Union, will not offer its tacit endorsement to the ongoing oppression of Uyghurs, Hong Kongers, Tibetans, and other groups within and outside the PRC's borders.
